In the Name of God Amen I Francis Kirkland
do order this as my last will and testament, That my Body be
recently buried, then my debts to be paid I Give to my wife Mary
Kirkland that part of Land whereon I now live to the Westward
of Little river, the said river to be the line, during her life time
then the said Land to be sold or divided at the discretion of my -
two Executors among my sons William Kirkland John Kirkland
and Francis Kirkland, further more my wife is to have one
sheath bed, two cows and calves two sows and pigs, I have to
my son Ambrose the remaining part of my Land to the Eastward
of Little river being the other part of the Tract that I left to my
wife, the remaining part of all my property I desire to be -
divided among my Children, William, John, Francis, Sarah,
Elizabeth, Mary, Abigail, and Constance reserving each of the same
a fields part for my wife during her widowhood, then the same
to be divided among my surviving Heirs, And I do further
constitute Richard Urwin and John Urwin to be my lawful
Executors to carry my said will into Effect, in every part
thereof and if any dispute arise touching or concerning the
same my Executors is to settle such matters or disputes as they
in their Judgment shall think best. Given under
my hand and Seal this 12th day of October 1790
