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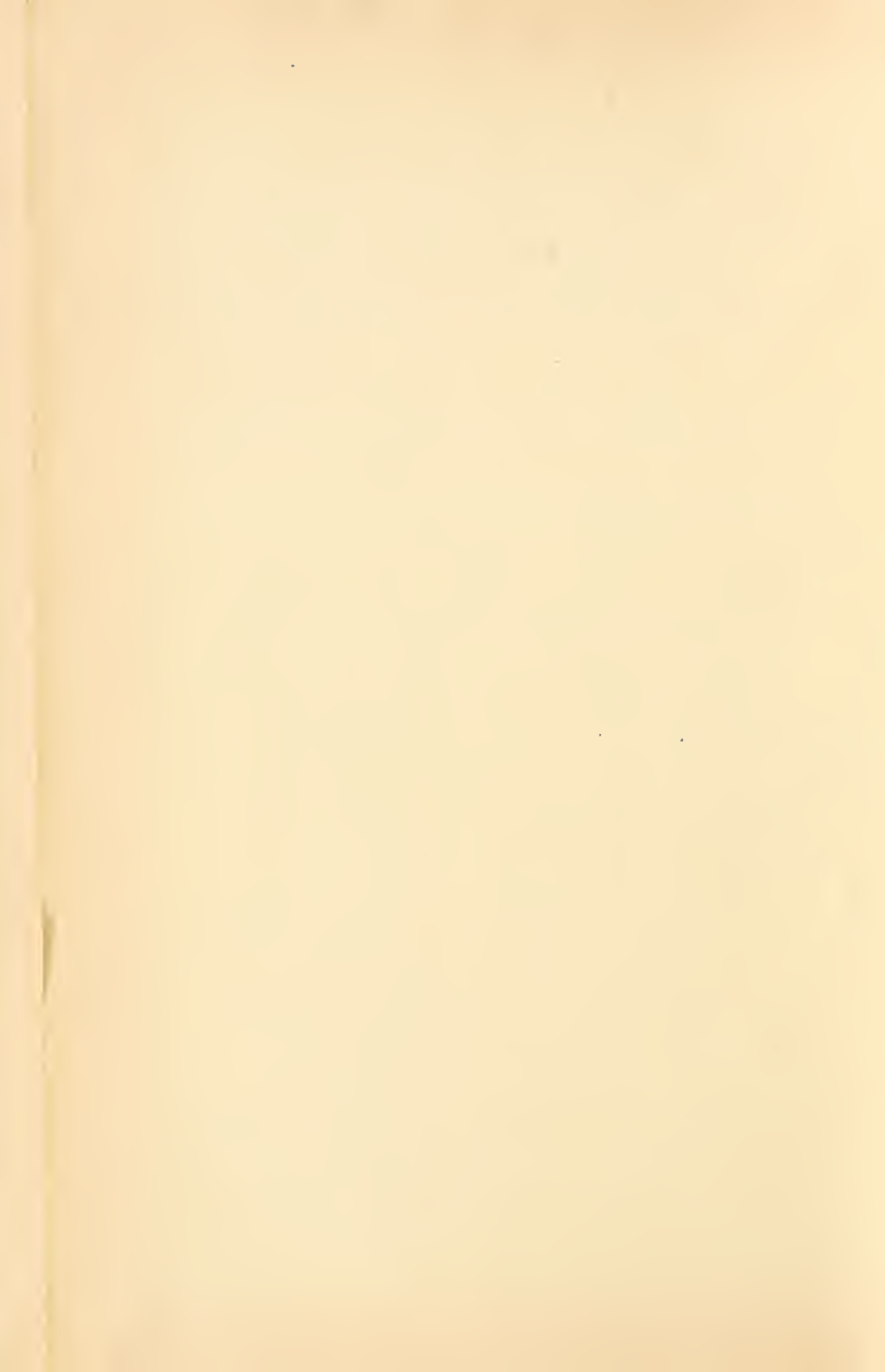

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To the survivors of the 3rd Regiment:

This inaccurate and incomplete roster of the 3rd Regiment is published in this tentative form for the purpose of getting corrections and additions made to it, so that it may then be revised for incorporation in a larger roster of the South Carolina troops in the service of the Confederate States. You are therefore earnestly requested to go over it carefully and add such facts and data as you can be absolutely certain of the correctness of, either from your personal knowledge or from the showing of contemporary records, and report such corrections or additions to the undersigned. (If you have any Confederate records in your custody the writer would be obliged for a loan of them.) You are particularly requested to give your FULL name and the *exact date of your birth* for insertion and the exact dates of death of such comrades as have died since the war. The exact date of your enlistment, surrender and parole is requested, and dates of any commissions, promotions or transfers you may have received.

The Confederate records in the keeping of the Historical Commission consist of rolls which have been compiled from memory by surviving members of the various companies or from incomplete contemporary records by indifferent and untrained clerks, Rivers's "Roll of Honor" of the Confederate dead from South Carolina and a few original records. With the exception of the latter these records have been copied by hand or printed several times and there are clerical errors and printer's errors both to contend with, so that the difficulty of presenting an accurate compilation is apparent.

If you learn of any of your comrades who have not received copies of this pamphlet notify the writer and each of them will be supplied with a copy.

“Robert Y. Hayne and His Times.”

“*Robert Y. Hayne and His Times*,” reviewed by Nathaniel Wright Stephenson, Professor of History and Economics, College of Charleston: “To paint the portrait of a community is one of the largest achievements of the muse of history, one that she seldom contrives to get accomplished by a single hand. As a rule, it must be built up piece-meal, and for its completion much time and a host of contributions are required. The faculties involved are also a problem. There must come into play the most severe sense of fact, the most impartial detachment from the claims of partisanship, and yet there must go with these a vivid sympathy which will impart to the dry bones the breath of life. That was what led Macauley to long for the time when there would be no more need to go to Hume for one-half of James the First and to Scott for the other.

“The history of South Carolina has long offered to the historian a variety of neglected opportunities. The great career of Calhoun; his strange, wonderful veiled character; the exact nature of the society which accepted so enthusiastically the leadership of that austere philosopher; the underlying psychology of that community; what other influences were of first moment besides Calhoun; these and more await their portrait painter. Any contribution to our better understanding of them, to our vivid apprehension of them, is precious.

“Mr. Theodore Jervay, in the book which he now has in press, ‘*Robert Y. Hayne and His Times*,’ makes a valuable contribution to the data of American History. The comparative obscurity into which Hayne has fallen moved Mr. Jervay, some time since, to set about an argument against the justice of Time in this

respect. As he worked, the complete injustice of the latter-day disregard of Hayne grew upon him until the desire to attempt a correction of it became the animus of the present volume. His subject widened from a discussion of the personal career of the one man into an examination, critically conducted, of the community which produced him; whose life formed his ideals, for whose good he labored so devotedly, and which, it may be, has not accorded him all the honor that is his due. Two tasks were thus forced into conjunction—the narration of Hayne's life and the depicting in something like a series of dissolving views the state of society at various dates in South Carolina—and the result was the form of the new treatise, a volume of some five hundred pages which will soon be issued by MacMillan.

It opens with a glimpse of Charleston life in the year of Hayne's birth, 1791—the year of Washington's visit. The plan of the work appears to include a tolerably full delineation of the general field of politics at each of the crucial moments in Hayne's career. At first glance a careless reader might be deceived as to the purpose of these carefully detailed settings which are frequently readjusted, and might, in his heedlessness, protest against them. To such a reader it might be well to recall that in a theater the setting changes from scene to scene—as it does in life. Too many biographers, in flat contradiction of life, have been content to delineate a setting for their central figure once and for all, leaving all the subsequent changes and readjustments of it, which invariably take place, to the puzzled imagination of the reader. Mr. Jervey has endeavored to avoid this discrepancy between a changing and evolving central figure and a setting which shows the same features from beginning to end, from curtain rise to curtain fall, by the method indicated.

hit off in a few sentences. It is safe, however, to say that at the bottom of the book lie some such convictions as these: The South Carolina of 1810 was distinctly different in characteristics from the South Carolina of 1840; the transformation of the earlier society into the latter was due to the pressure of a variety of forces, among which economic conditions, partly local, partly general, were of profound importance; Hayne's life overlapped the entire era of transition; he was born long before any signs of it appeared; he grew up, took his cast of mind, in the older society which was destined to undergo great changes during his maturity; the chief significance of his career is his attempts to meet the startling issues forced upon his State by new forces he was powerless to command out of existence; therefore, a close study of his life will reveal a clue to the entire period.

"The data collected by Mr. Jervey are of first importance. He has put into accessible form many things, brought to get her from a great variety of sources, which, hitherto, were not available to the general reader, nor even to the student unless he had illimitable time at his disposal. With diligence and complete devotion to research, Mr. Jervey has accumulated here what is probably a definitive mass of evidence with regard to Hayne's life.

"But he is not content to be a mere compiler. There are plenty of vexed questions—at times, one is tempted to say there are nothing but vexed questions in American History between 1820 and 1840. If Mr. Jervey had done no more than put in reach of us all this important collection of data he would still have deserved the thanks of every student; still more he deserves our thanks for adding to the discussion a closely reasoned interpretation of the facts. He takes care to make it easy for the reader to separate the two—the data and the theory—and if after following the

argument, one should be inspired to take up the cudgels for the view of Hayne as a negligible quantity, a mere understudy of Calhoun, why the lists are open and the judges are no respecters of persons. Mr. Jervcy's position is plain. He considers Hayne one of the ablest of South Carolinians, who deserves and eventually will have, a place among those American statesmen that are held to be of general significance, without considering whom no true history of the United States can be written.

"As a national figure—using 'national' in that sense of pertaining to us all, for which we have no other term—Hayne has had less regard of late years than he deserves. Most students at the minute will probably agree to this. But Hayne lived in that State, which more than any other in the Union, has had a reputation for acting as a unit. Any man who contributed largely to the frame of mind of South Carolina between 1820 and 1840 was indirectly a national force. One thing which makes Hayne slightly bewildering is the fact that he fills a sort of compromise position, neither wholly of the great arena as is Calhoun; nor chiefly of the local one as is, for example McDuffie; and yet brilliantly an actor in both.

"Because of his exceptional position between the two arenas, Hayne's life presents his biographer with a task of maximum difficulty. That Mr. Jervcy has very manfully confronted its difficulties and has never sacrificed them to the mere ease of getting through with his tale, must be apparent to every fair-minded reader. That his conclusions, whether they are to be accepted as final, or are to be subject to further argument, are entirely free from any hint or shadow of mere partisanship, one would be dense to a degree not to perceive. And whatever one has to say upon Hayne hereafter, this book must be a part of one's subject matter."
