

PREFACE.

The Registers of Weddington commence in 1663, and consist of four Books, bringing the entries down to 1812.

The first is a parchment book, $12\frac{1}{2}$ by 4 ins., containing six leaves (*i.e.*, twelve pages), from 1663 to 1743. The three others are of paper, all measuring $8\frac{1}{4}$ by $6\frac{1}{2}$ ins., containing entries for the following years:—

II. Baptisms, 1788—1797; Marriages, 1777—1799; Burials, two entries only, in 1798. Six leaves.

III. Baptisms, 1800—1814; Marriages, one entry only, 1804; Burials, 1801—1812. Six pages used; remainder blank.

IV. Marriages, 1800—1806, with Banns from 1806 to the present time. Twenty-two leaves.

They are all in good condition, and the first volume has recently been bound.

This place seems to have been a favourite one for weddings from all parts of the surrounding country, perhaps on account of its name, for out of a total number of 275 entries of Baptisms, Marriages and Banns, and Burials, no less than 115 are Marriages.




