After a gale the seaweed which is piled on the coast by the waves is gathered for manure



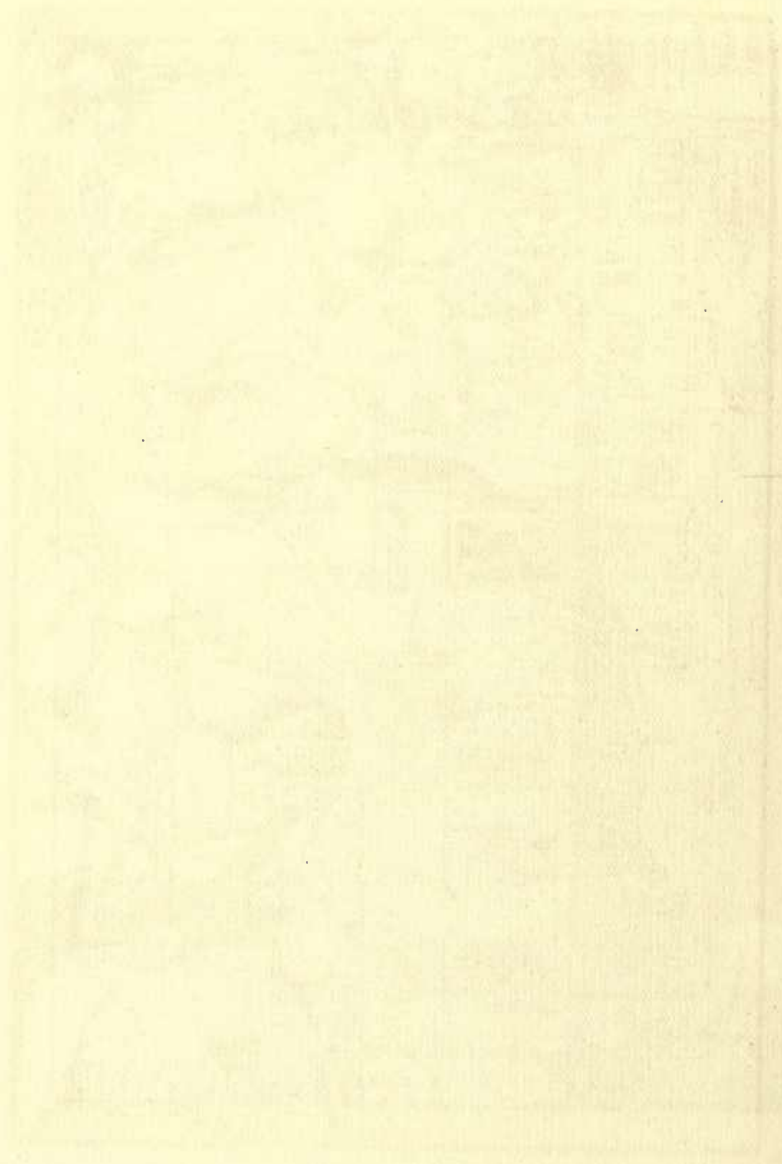

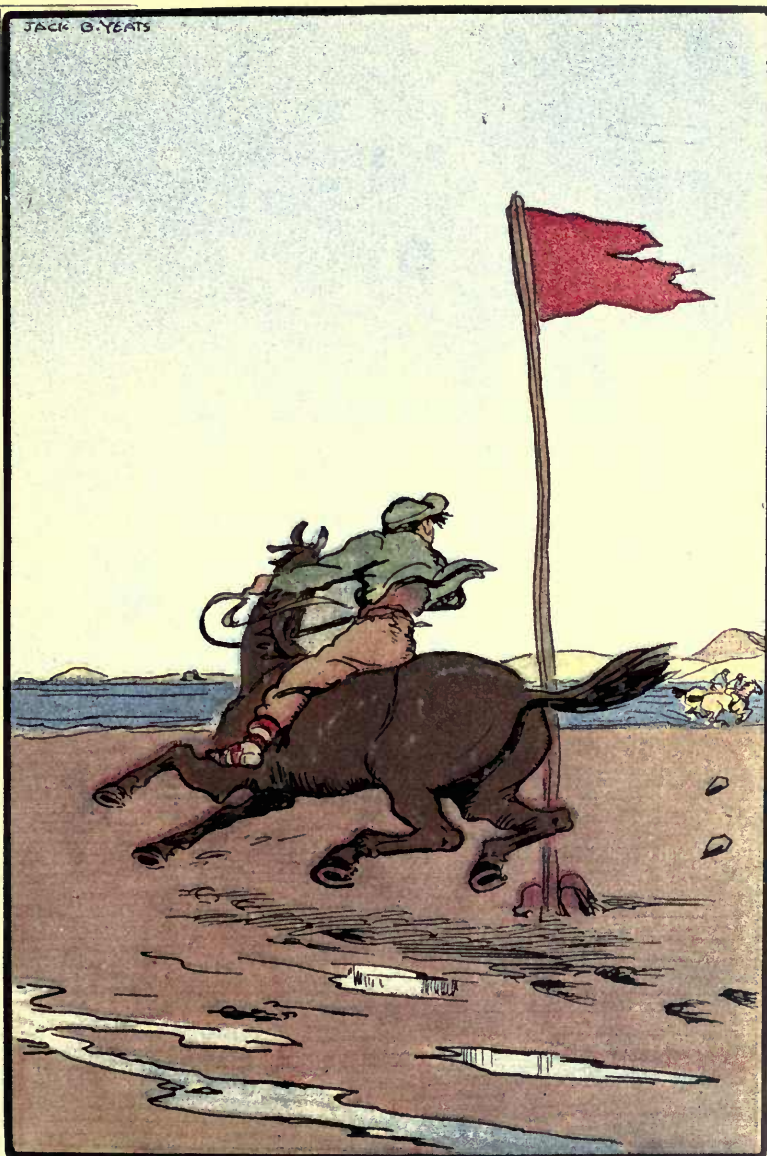




THE BARREL MAN

The charge is a penny for three throws. The barrel man defends himself with the sticks in his hands, and if hard pressed drops down into the barrel



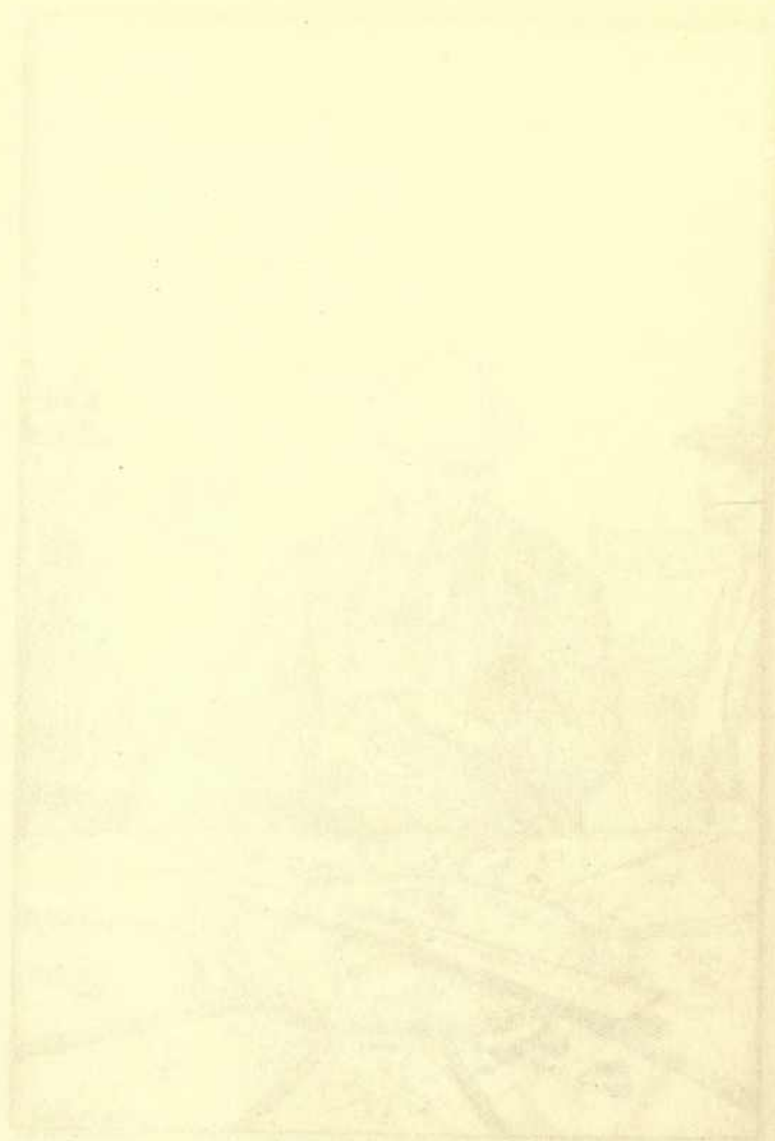

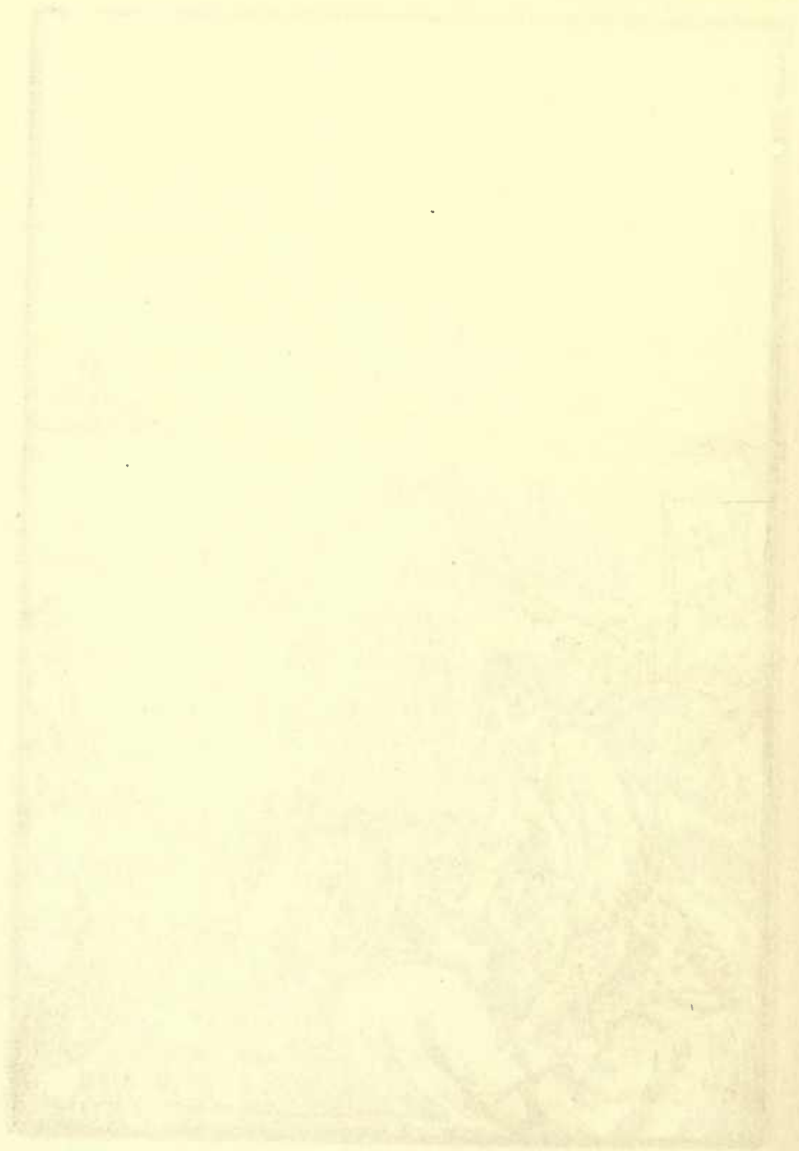

A kind of roulette.





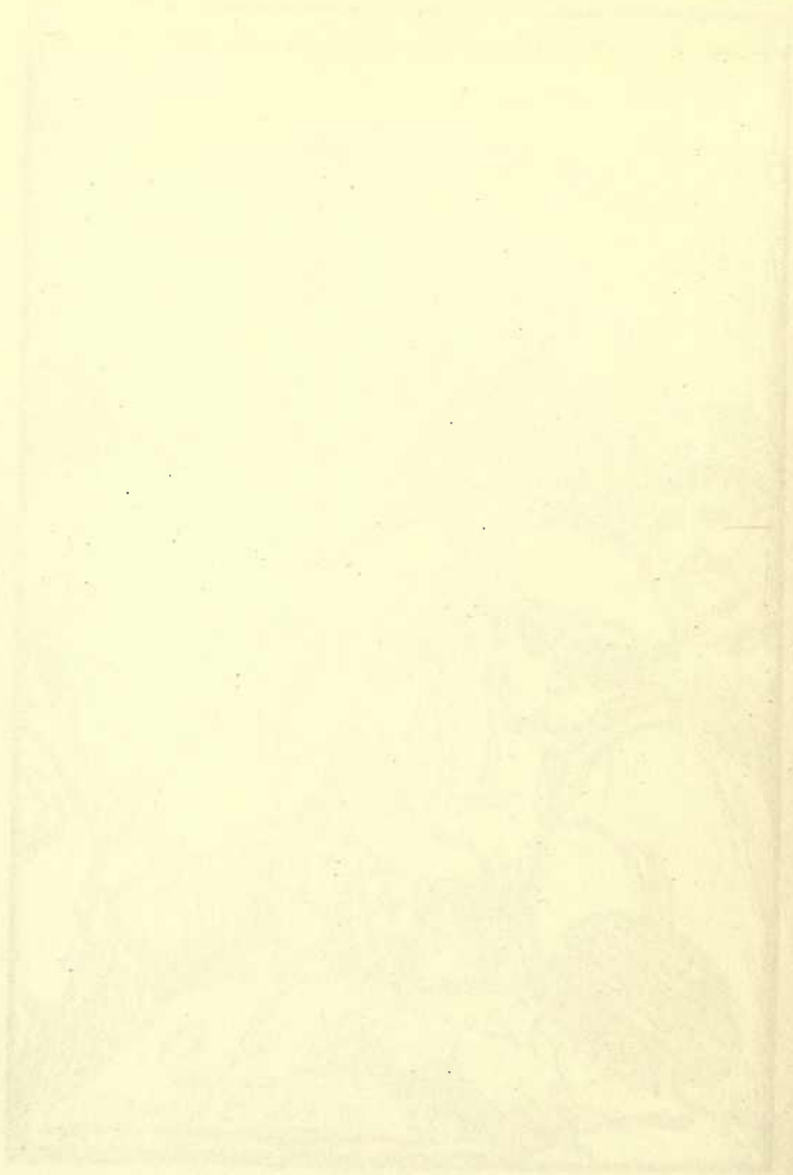

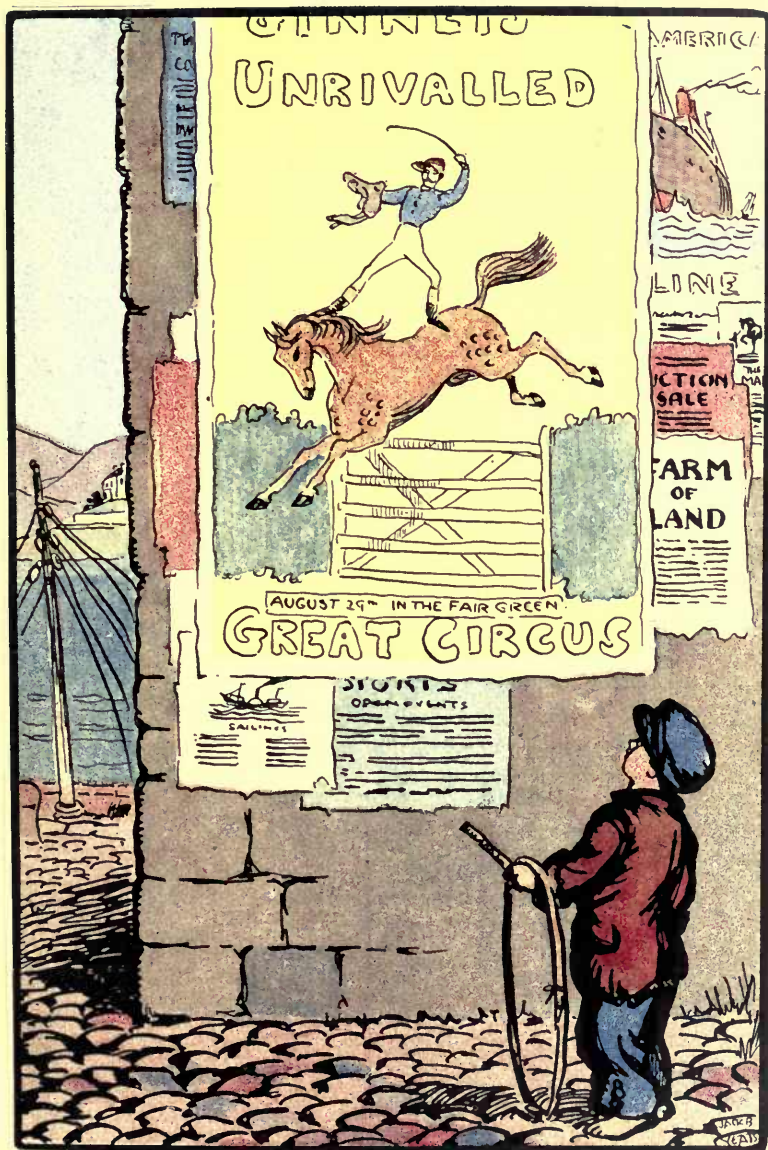




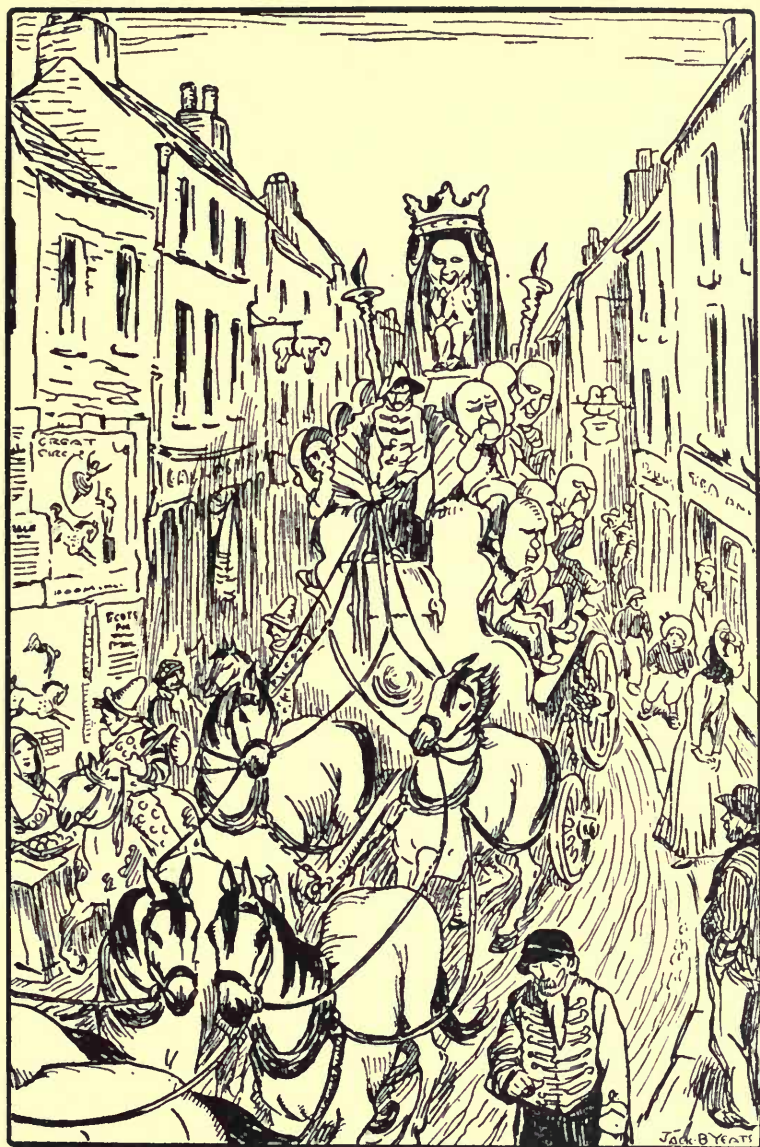
THE GAME OF "UNDER OR OVER"
