## World War 1

The commencement of World War 1 was declared on the 28 July 1914 but Great Britain's decision to mobilize was kept in abeyance until the 4th Aug 1914 when they joined France, Russia and Serbia, the war continued until June 23, 1919, with the official signing of the Treaty at Versailles, (Britain officially declared that the war was over on 31 August 1921). This War is often referred to as The Great War of 1914 to 1919.

Whilst one cannot go into the details of the war in a publication such as this, one can record the number of people involved. The British Empire mobilised 9,000,00 men and women, of whom 1,114,804 were killed and nearly 2,000,000 wounded. Of these 584,994 have indentified burials and cremations and 529,808 have no known grave.

Many Irish Regiments were involved in this war and , like other regiments,suffered many injured and dead. In this, the first of our Military Series of publications, we deal with three Regiments involved in this war.

The points of enlistment for the army for Roscommon residents at this time were - Athlone, Boyle, Longford, Ballinasloe, Oranmore, Castlerea, Strokestown and Birr. We have included the names of those enlisted at these points, some of whom may not be County Roscommon residents, but others, because of Union, postal or other boundaries were technically resident within the County.

Shortly after the end of the War, Her Majesty's Stationery Office issued an official publication listing,

Officers Died in the Great War, 1914-1919, a record of 39,000 officers who gave their lives in the war. This was followed in 1921 by Soldiers Died in the Great War 1914-1919, which was produced in eighty parts bound into seventy-five volumes and records the names of about 667,000 names. It is from the latter publication that we have extracted the following entries.

Each entry shows the full name of the soldier, place of birth (b.), place of enlistment (e.), place of residence if different from that of enlistment (.....), his army number, rank (Pte=Private etc.), how they died, place of death (F & F = France & Flanders, including Italy), date of death.

There are 15,000 burial places and memorials containing or recording the dead of the First World War. The Commonwealth War Graves Commission are responsible for the care of graves of all members of the imperial forces " who died from wounds inflicted, accident occurring or disease contracted, while on active service whether on sea or land". (The Commission was established by Royal Charter in May 1917 and supplemented by one in 1964). Registers have been published for most cemeteries or memorials, although it is a major task to pursue a name, (they are in alphabetical order) you have to consider the fact that in the case of France and Flanders there are 22 major memorials and 2,300 cemeteries involving 725,000 dead. Having found the cemetery the Commission produce maps to locate a particular cemetery and which, if you wish, you can visit ( The British Legion yearly arrange visits to the major cemeteries and memorials, c/f back page for address).

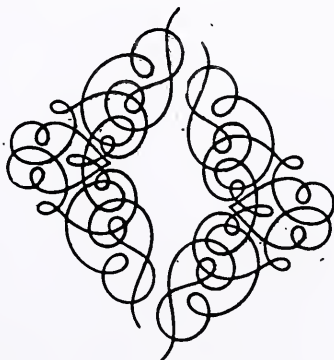
