## ELLIOT, YORK COUNTY, MAINE.

Parsons, Usher,

NICHOLAS FROST came to Piscataqua about the year 1636, and settled at Sturgeon Creek, now Elliot, Maine. He died July 20, 1663, aged about 74 years. He held the office of constable, 1640 and 1641, and of selectman in 1652. He left the following children:

A. CHARLES, born in Tiverton, England, July 30th, 1631. He married Mary, daughter of Joseph Bowles, of Wells. He was killed by the Indians, July 4th, 1697. He will hereafter be designated as Major Charles Frost. She died November, 1704.

B. John, who settled at Isle of Shoals. Died, 1718. He carried on fisheries at Star Island. He left a widow, named Sarah; a son John, who inherited the York estate; and three grandsons, the oldest, named John, the other two Samuel and Ithamar. John (3d.) inherited his father's estate in York. He had one daughter who married William Smith.



- C. Catherine, who married John Leighton, had two children, viz. John and Elizabeth. The latter died young. The son was ancestor of a numerous race, among whom was Major Samuel Leighton, who was in the revolutionary army, and a great grandson, General Samuel Leighton, who died at Alfred, October 13th, 1848. Catherine married for a second husband, Joseph Hammond, a prominent man, who held the office of Register of Probate, and also of Judge. She died August 1, 1715.
- D. NICHOLAS, who pursued the life of a sailor, was apprenticed as such to Thomas Orchard, by his brother, Charles, (appointed guardian, Nicholas being a minor when his father died.) He died at Limerick, Ireland, Agust 1, 1673, unmarried, and left his property to the children of Charles and Catherine.
- E. ELIZABETH, married William Smith, a merchant in Boston.

John Frost, of New Castle, was appointed to command the ship-of-war, Edward, in 1709. He was subsequently one of her Majesty's Council, in New Hampshire.

The family-bible, now in possession of John N. Frost, of Portsmouth, was printed in 1599, and is represented to have belonged to Nicholas Frost. It was owned by Major Charles Frost, and was given by his widow, Mary, to her son, the Honorable John, in July, 1697; and by Mary, widow of John, to their son William; by William to his eldest son Benjamin, and by Benjamin to his youngest son, John Newmarch Frost, of Portsmouth, New Hampshire.



A. MAJOR CHARLES FROST married Mary Bowles.

Was extensively engaged in mercantile business, became wealthy; was Representative and Councillor, and will be known in this Genealogy as Honorable John Frost. He married Mary Pepperrell, sister of Sir William Pepperrell, September 4, 1702. She was born September 4, 1685. She married again, Rev. Dr. Colman, of Boston, August 12, 1745. He died, August 29, 1747. She married again, Rev. Benjamin Prescott, of Danvers, Massachusetts, October 6, 1748. She died April 18, 1766, aged 80 years, 7 months and 3 days, and was buried in a tomb at Danvers, Massachusetts.

[John Frost, LL. D., of Philadelphia, son of Nathaniel and Abigail Frost, and grandson of Brigadier General John Frost, was born January 26, 1800, at Kennebunk, Maine. Graduated at Harvard College, 1822. Head master of Mayhew School, Boston, from 1823 to 1828. Removed to Philadelphia, was Professor of Belles Letters, in Central High School, from 1838 to 1845.
