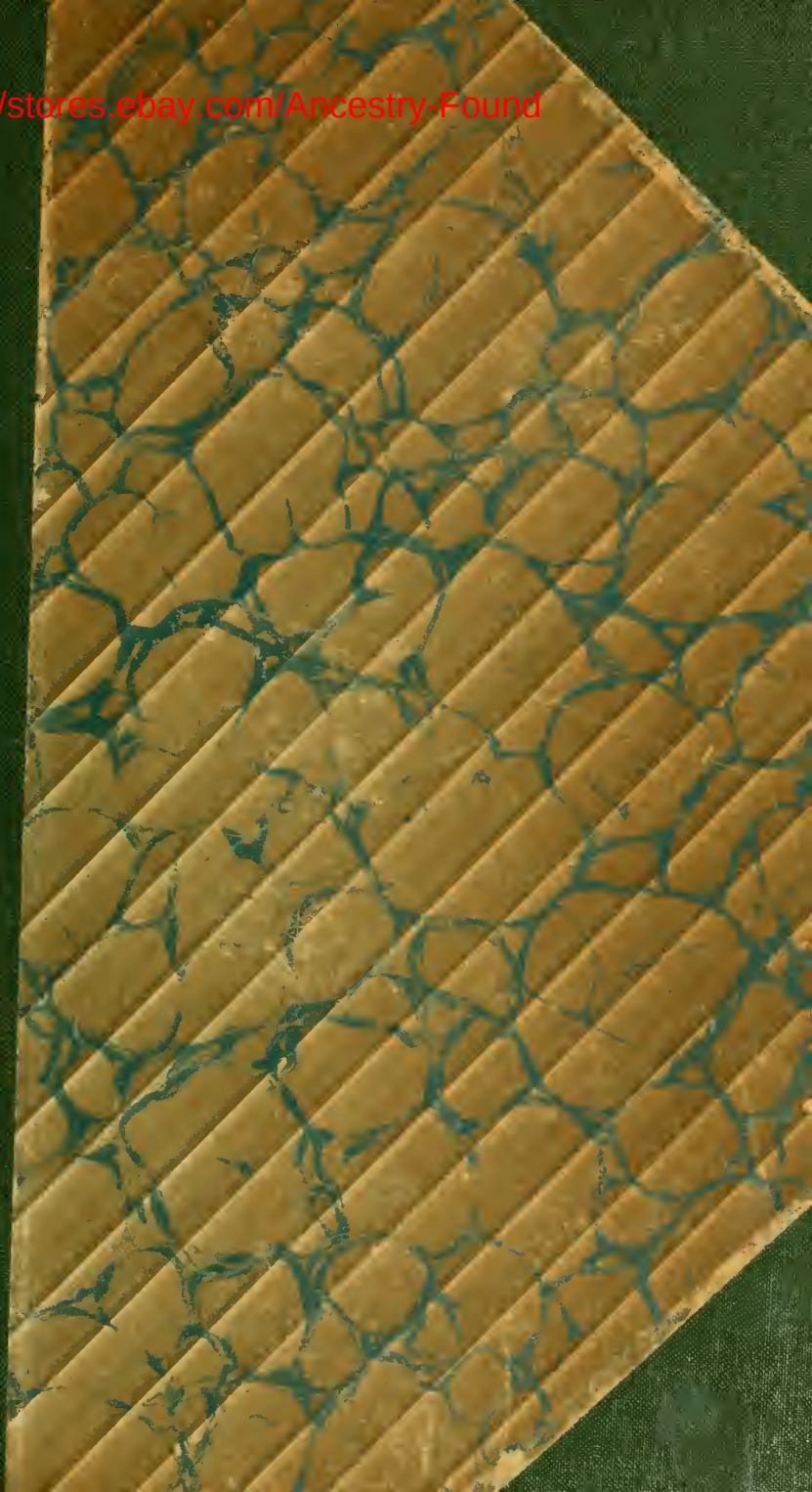

Intentions of Marriage : volume one : 1719 to 1741 : but it also contains records from 1704 to 1776 : which are also included here.

The original peculiar speklings are kept : the writing in the original, almost faded in many instances, is very difficult to read : hence the many question marks : the marriage records of many of these INTENTIONS, do not seem to be on record : this makes these Intentions all the more valuable, for family genealogy.

The book is a small vellum bound volume in the Friend's safe on East fifteen Street, New York City.

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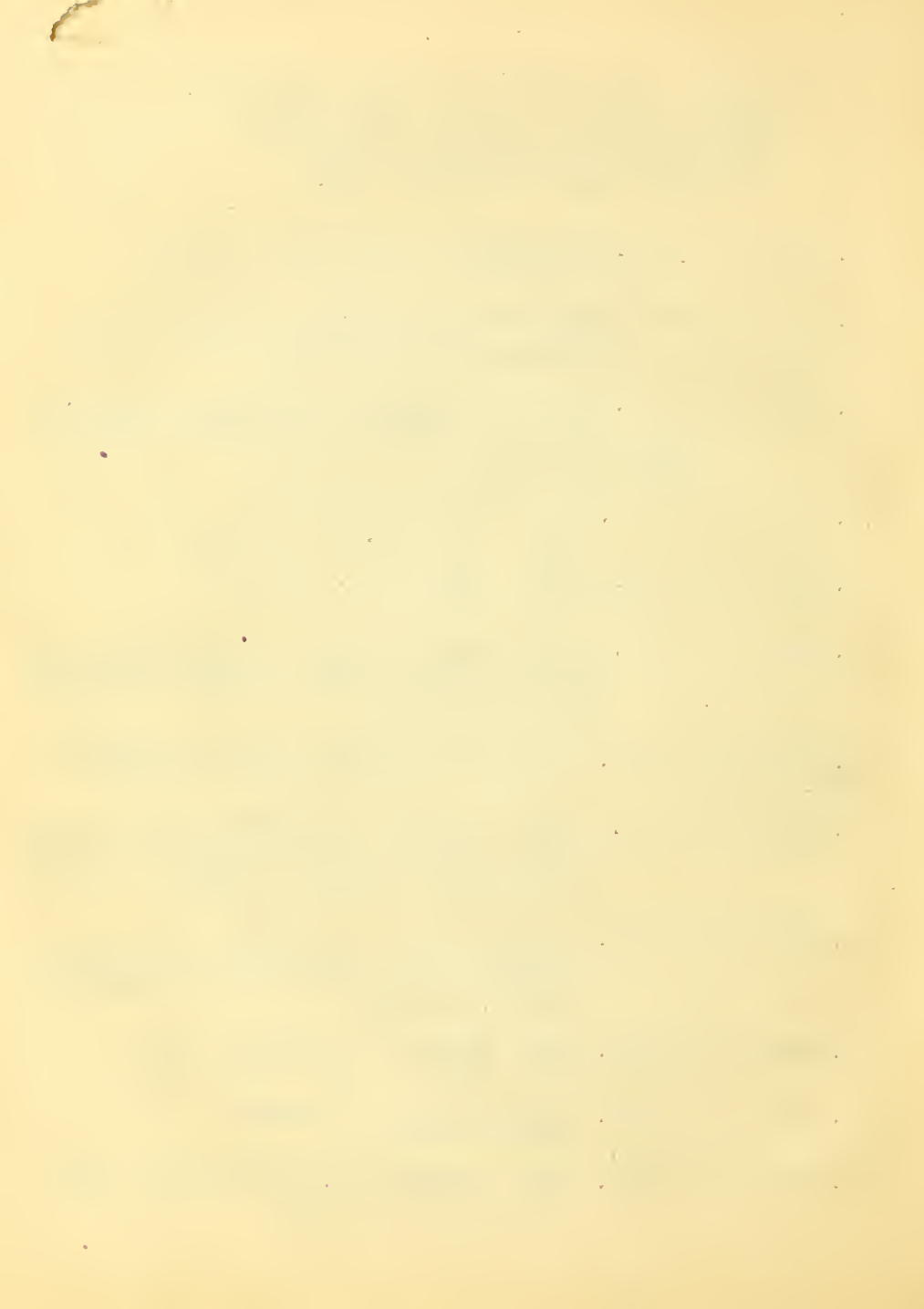
