Father--Hugh Walter Dickson born in London, England, March 5, 1853. He came to USA and landed in New York City in 1876. Married in Rosemont, KS. Oct. 21, 1891 to Mary Ledoska Laws. Became Naturalized Citzen March 9, 1906. He died Sept. 2, 1928 in Rosemont, KS. He was buried in Mt. Hope Cemetery in Williamsburg, KS.

Mother--Mary Ledoska Laws born Nov. 29, 1869 in State of Illinois. Died April 10, 1948 in a hospital in Ottawa, KS. She was buried in Mt. Hope Cemetery in Williamsburg, KS. She listed her father, James Laws born in Franklin Co., OH. Dec. 20, 1820. Served in Union Army in Civil War. Married Mary Ann "Polly" Lowe May 11, 1845 in Rush Co, IN. They had eleven children. James Laws died April 21, 1878 in Franklin Co., KS. where he was buried. Mary Ann "Polly" died May 10, 1897 in Rosemont, KS. and was buried in Pleasant View Cemetery in Osage Co., KS.

Sister--Alice Maude Dickson born in Rosemont, KS. Aug. 14, 1892. Served as US Army nurse in WWI. Married Jasper William Kennedy June 25, 1919 in Indiana. Married 2nd Andrew DeYoung. Died April 5, 1988 in North Kansas City, MO. Buried in Mt. Hope Cemetery in Williamsburg, KS.

Sister--Katie Dickson born Sept. 26, 1894 in Rosemont, KS. Died July 15, 1895. Buried in Pleasant View Cemetery in Osage Co., KS.

Sister--Mary Elizabeth "Bessie" Dickson born Sept 26, 1895 in Rosemont, KS. Died Oct. 14, 1918 as a volunteer nurse for the army during the flue epedemic. Buried in Mt. Hope Cemetery in Williamsburg, KS.

Brother--Walter Belton Dickson born Dec. 13, 1897 in Rosemont, KS. Born in served in the US Marine Corp. in World War I. He married Naomi Courtney Feb. 16, 1924 in Covington, Kentucky. She died May 22, 1984 in Lenexa, KS. He died June 22, 1988 in Olathe, KS. He and Naomi are buried in Memorial Park Cemetery in Kansas City, MO.
