This book is put forth that it may enable its readers to preserve from generation to generation the lineage of descent of the Illustrious McConnell Family. It is not altogether a written treatise, but rather a reunion of the descendants of this renowned family of Virginia. The McConnell Family is lucky in having the service of those so capable in research, and in compiling and presenting information so interesting for the book.

The blood and marriage relation of the early generation of the McConnell family in Virginia is given. Beginning with Sheriff George McConnell, prominent in the early government of Scott county, a complete list of his family of children, with the name of the person each married, is shown. In the next Chapter the names obtainable of his grandchildren surviving infancy, are presented with the names of the persons they married. To better reveal the family connection and record the marriage genealogy, the wife's name before marriage is given with the husband's name. In order to record and preserve the McConnell Marriage Genealogy, on the fourth page a form is conveniently arranged for filling in the entire lineage of one descendant per book, even to the sixth generation.

Next, in successive Chapters are given some leading families, descendants of Sheriff George McConnell, with their descendants even to the present young generation. The family and descendants are altogether in the same Chapter, and the order of birth in each family, as ascertained, is inviolate. The book also includes a brief McConnell history in Ireland. The McConnells mentioned in this genealogy, with all their descendants, possibly constitute only a twig, or branch of the great McConnell Family Tree located in many counties, cities, and countries of the world.

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CHAPTER I

General Remarks

The McConnell Family of the United States being of high rank, this book gives the ancestors, descendants, and marriages of this renowned family of Virginia. Before this, only the names, comparatively, of a few individuals, have been mentioned in conferring honors. In this book the names of all (intended) from George McConnell, Sr., emigrant from Ireland, to the present generation, are assembled for neighborly enjoyment, family history, and the benefit of future generations. This is a matter which demonstrates its growing interest and importance with the passing years. Bouquets of flowers to any one, by chance, left out. If any just write the name in the proper place, and let the bells ring, the bands play, and the flags wave a "genuine family welcome."

Neither time nor expense have been spared in getting the family genealogy lists complete, saving some deceased in infancy, ever cared for by the angels in Heaven. The order of birth in each family has been carefully preserved according to the best remembrance and information obtained, the birth of twins indicated, one family having two sets. Some mention is made of professions, honors, distinctions, etc. of individuals, but the authors confess that the work is rather inadequate in this respect not being acquainted with all the achievements, and the limited knowledge of this life being too imperfect sometimes to judge just where honors and laurels should be sufficiently placed. Also a sure foundation of this work, the glory and strength of the nation, are the working people, and "An honest yeomanry—a country's pride."

McCONNELL MARRIAGE GENEALOGY

One interesting feature of this book is not in dates and deaths, but in a perfect revelry of marriages. Some not reported as married may be so before this book is off the press. The fact of birth and existence, and the union of individuals and families by marriages are always very interesting subjects of universal concern. All people and nations are interested in the welfare of each other. Weddings are the hilarious times of all youth, and many fond remembrances of life are of wedding celebrations. What a score of important occurrences and pageant recollections this book will afford and suggest to many as they turn through its pages! 'Around the old home place, and the new ones, cluster many sweet memories of most all the happiness this life really contains, recalled by seeing the family names, acquaintances and friends together. Every family mentioned has had days of joy, and doubtless, also, moments of sorrow and tears, along with the many struggles and achievements in the onward march of life.

In a brief way, this book is somewhat a biography of a great many known persons. At least it will keep a record and serve a purpose along that line. From the Contents which make reference by chapters, the genealogy of any family in the book should be quickly found. In the final chapter is given a number of places and postoffices in the United States which have derived their names from McConnell showing the national prestige of the name.

SHERIFF GEORGE McCONNELL

Sheriff George McConnell (a weaver by trade), and his wife, Susan Snively-McConnell, came from Pennsylvania to Elk Garden, Virginia, and from there to Scott county, where he was High Sheriff in the pioneer days of the county when Judge Estill (for whom Estillville was named), was on the bench.

With George McConnell and wife, also came from Pennsylvania his sister and some of his wife's people. His sister married Philip Dingus of Scott county. Her sons and daughters married into leading families of the county, and from them have descended very noble citizens of the state. The Snively families located in other counties of Virginia. J. R. Cowden of the efficient Nickelsville U. S. Mail Service, however, is a descendant, and thereby relation of Sheriff George and Susan McConnell's folks.

In O'Hart's Irish Pedigrees or Origin and Stem of the Irish Nation, Vol. II, MacConnell in Tyrone county, and MacConnell in Londonderry county, are alphabetically given among the many families in Ireland from the 11th to the end of the 16th Century.

In Vol. I, mention is made of Meagher's Irish Brigade in service of America under General Thomas Francis Meagher in the American War of 1861-1865; McConnell, Lieut. 63 N. Y. Volunteers, McConnell, Henry, Adjutant 63 N. Y. Volunteers. This Brigade was in service in Massachusetts, Pennsylvania and New York.
