# FOREWORD

This collection of records developed from a search amongst naturalizations for genealogical information concerning some of the Germans who settled in western Maryland. In examining the records of eighteenth century naturalizations, valuable data beyond mere names and dates were discovered. The sole key to these records, a card index, was found to be incomplete and to contain serious errors. In order to add to the literature about the Germans who migrated to Colonial Maryland, this complete set of naturalizations granted according to two eighteenth century English statutes was extracted from Maryland's Provincial Court documents. Parliament intended the two naturalization laws to encourage Germans specifically, so long as they were Protestant, to emigrate to Maryland. But numerous non-German Protestant immigrants took advantage of the liberality of the laws to gain civil rights. Therefore, the compilation of those naturalization records, Part III of this volume, should assist genealogists and demographers whose interests lie both within and outside the German element.

An account of the English statute naturalizations provides an incomplete picture of the naturalization process in Colonial Maryland. Therefore, the extant recorded naturalizations accomplished by means other than the English laws have been included here. Part I of this book lists those immigrants who acquired limited rights of citizenship through denization during the seventeenth century. Part II provides the available information on persons who received naturalization via enactment of private bills by the colonial legislature.

The data of Parts I and II have previously been published, scattered throughout various volumes of the Maryland Archives. Part III consists of material which, with the exception of the names of 128 of the immigrants, has not heretofore appeared in print.

All of the entries in this volume have been carefully transcribed from the sources and checked for accuracy. Still it is difficult to eliminate error completely and the authors apologize for problems which may arise from their mistakes. Controversy may be resolved by consulting the referenced source, either the Maryland Archives volumes or the Court documents at the Hall of Records in Annapolis.

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The Lords Baltimore recognized from the earliest settlement of their Province of Maryland that success depended, in nearly every respect, upon expansion of the population. To encourage settlement, private citizens who paid the cost of transporting able-bodied males were offered rewards of land under the terms of the Conditions of Plantation.<sup>1</sup> At first, there were no express limitations on whom might claim the rewards; but by 1642 the Conditions restricted claimants to those "of Brittish or Irish descent."<sup>2</sup> The change reflected the fear of placing lands and potential power in foreigners whose loyalty to Lord and King might not be undivided. By 1649, however, Lord Baltimore was willing to relent slightly and he authorized his colonial representatives, in their discretion, to make grants of land to persons of French, Dutch or Italian descent who otherwise fulfilled the Conditions of Plantation then in force.<sup>3</sup>

The first application of the intent of the 1649 declaration arose not from the contemplated direct importation of aliens, but from one of the Baltimores' many boundary disputes. The Swedish and Dutch settlers of the village of New Amstel on Delaware Bay were thought to be encroaching upon Proprietary lands. Forcible expulsion of the putative intruders was suggested by some, but skillful negotiators, including Augustine Herman, the Bohemian cartographer of Maryland, prevailed.<sup>4</sup> For their part of the agreement, some of

the settlers, including Herman, moved to territory indisputably within Baltimore's jurisdiction. In return, Lord Baltimore conferred some property rights upon individual settlers, even though they were not born within the British dominions. The first of those conferrals of denization, an adaptation of a Royal power, was issued in 1660.<sup>5</sup> The recipients of the denizations acquired status well beneath that of the natural-born or naturalized citizen.

A denizen is an alien born, but who has obtained *ex donatione regis*, letters patent to make him an English subject, a high and incommunicable branch of the royal prerogative. He may take lands by purchase or devise, which an alien may not; but cannot take by inheritance; for his parent, through whom he must claim, being an alien, had no inheritable blood; and therefore could convey none to the son. And upon a like defect of hereditary blood, the issue of a denizen, cannot inherit to him; but his issue born after may. No denizen can be of the Privy Council, or either House of Parliament, or have any office of trust, civil or military, or be capable of any grant of land, etc., from the Crown.<sup>6</sup>

Lord Baltimore's denizations were only as broad as his sovereignty; his denizens' rights as to land, its acquisition and disposal, pertained only to Maryland. The letters of denization typically noted this limitation:

...and likewise any land Tenements Revenues Services and other hereditaments whatsoever within our said province of Maryland may inherit or otherwise purchase receive take have hold buy

and possess and then may occupie and enjoy Give Sell alien and bequeath as likewise all liberties franchises priuiledges of this our province"

The denizens soon became dissatisfied with their few property rights and sought greater opportunities. In 1666, James Neale, an Englishman whose children had been born outside the British dominions, desired to confirm his children's rights of inheritance before undertaking another task in service of the Crown. Neale pursued his goal by requesting passage of a private naturalization measure by the Assembly and the Provincial Council. Augustine Herman followed Neale's lead and filed a petition for himself, members of his family, and others, asking that they "...henceforth be adjudged reputed & taken as Well borne people of the Province of Maryland..." Herman pointed to the spirit of Lord Baltimore's declaration of 1649 and warned that the failure to grant fuller rights of citizenship than those of denization would result in "...foreclosing the peopling of this Province with usefull Artificers & handicrafts men..." The legislature agreed and a bill in Herman's favor was enacted the same day that Neale's act was passed.<sup>7</sup> Thereafter legislative naturalization became firmly established and denization was doomed to wither. In addition to the denizens' rights, a legislatively-natural-

ized citizen could, in Maryland,

...maintain Prosecute Avow Justifie and defend All manner of Actions Suits Pleas Plaints and other Demands whatsoever, as Liberally, Frankly Freely, fully, lawfully and Securely as if they ...had been Natrall born People and Subjects of this province!2...

Although legislative naturalizations continued to be enacted for specific individuals, general naturalization statutes were rejected in 1669 and 1671.<sup>15</sup> A 1692 naturalization statute merely set out the procedure that had been followed up to that time: upon advice and consent of the Assembly and the Council, the governor could administer an oath of allegiance to a settled alien and issue him letters patent making him for "...all intents and Purposes, fully and completely Naturalized."<sup>16</sup>

In 1735, a general naturalization statute of three year's duration was enacted in Maryland, permitting the colonial governor to issue naturalizations without the approval of the Assembly.<sup>17</sup> The general naturalization statute added the oath of abjuration to the naturalization requirements. That oath required each applicant for citizenship to pledge allegiance to the Protestant King and his successors and to repudiate the Pope, the doctrine of Transubstantiation, and the claims of the Catholic James III, "the Old Pretender."<sup>18</sup> This statute was renewed twice, expiring in 1740.<sup>17</sup>

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In 1740, Parliament finally took notice of the flow of non-English immigrants into the American colonies and adopted a measure under which those immigrants could acquire almost the same status as British subjects. Section I of the act, 13 Geo. II c.7, provided that those aliens who resided in America for seven consecutive years, without an absence that exceeded two months in duration, and who swore the anti-Catholic oath of abjuration (Quakers could affirm) before a colonial provincial court between 9 a.m. and noon, could be granted essentially all the rights of citizenship for a fee of two shillings.<sup>18</sup> Section II required each applicant, except Quakers and Jews, to present a certificate at court, attested by two witnesses, that he had been administered a Protestant communion within the preceding three months. Section III allowed Jews to omit the words "upon the true faith of a christian" in swearing the required oaths. Section IV authorized the issuance of a certificate of naturalization by the court. Section V ordered each colonial secretary to forward annually a list of those naturalized in his province to the commissioners of trade in London.<sup>19</sup> Parliament was soon made aware that the swearing of oaths was abhorrent to more of the American immigrants than the Quakers. In 1747, the statute 20 Geo. II c.44 relieved the "...Moravian brethren and other foreign protestants, not Quakers, who conscientiously scruple the taking of an oath..." of the oath tests.<sup>20</sup> Certificates of communion were still required and the political limitations

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imposed by the 13 Geo. II c.7 statute were reiterated: those so naturalized were not eligible to sit in Parliament or any other higher council of the British government. That political limitation presented no foreseeable difficulty for the Maryland immigrants, particularly for the Germans who were settling Maryland's backwoods. The easing of the oath requirement meant that virtually all of the non-Catholic alien immigrants, even the Anabaptists, could, for the first time, acquire citizenship that was universal in the American colonies.<sup>21</sup>

This Parliamentary means of naturalization became the most popular method of acquiring rights of citizenship in colonial Maryland. Maryland's Provincial Court granted citizenship to more than one thousand immigrants from 1742 to 1775 by this procedure. The more limited legislative naturalization route remained available, but its use dwindled.

Few of the new citizens who followed the Parliamentary course of naturalization suffered from its political restrictions. For example, Elie Vallete's Parliamentary naturalization of 1764 was a qualification, not a bar, to his service as the clerk of the Prerogative Court of Maryland from 1764 to 1777.<sup>22</sup> But Jonathan Hagar, the founder of Hagerstown, Maryland, discovered that a different standard applied to elected office. Following the precedent of the statute 12 & 13 William III c.2, the 13 Geo. II c.7 statute, under which Hagar was naturalized in 1747, disqualified Hagar and those

like him from ever taking a seat in Parliament. The Maryland government had adopted the same stance in 1716, disqualifying from assembly seats those who were ineligible to sit in Parliament.<sup>23</sup> Thus when Hagar was elected to the Assembly in 1771, the matter of his eligibility was raised and the other Assembly members voted to exclude him.<sup>24</sup> However, a hastily passed Maryland statute established eligibility for persons in Hagar's situation. Hagar was reelected and seated, barely a month after the issue arose.<sup>25</sup> A similar controversy cropped up at the 1773 session of the Assembly and, after another brief exclusion, Hagar was again permitted to participate.<sup>26</sup> Hagar's success perfected the civil rights, in colonial Maryland, of the settlers who obtained Parliamentary naturalization and established the opportunity for them to participate fully in the life of their adopted land.

# EXPLANATORY NOTES

The format of the information derived from the different types of naturalization records which are presented in Parts I, II, and III has been kept as uniform as possible. The maximum amount of information which could be contained in each kind of line within a record is explained below in the same order used in the text. No original record is complete in all of these details.

- Line type 1. Identifying number of the record.  
(In Part I a "D" and in Part II an "N" precedes the number. Entries in Part III have no alphabetical prefix.)
- Date of naturalization or denization.  
Date of communion (Part III only).
- Source volume and page.  
(The source of Parts I and II is the Maryland Archives. References in Part III are to Provincial Court Judgments libers on deposit at the Hall of Records.)
- Line type 2. Name of person naturalized or denitized.  
County or town of residence.  
Occupation.  
City and/or nationality of origin.  
Relationship to head of household.  
(Parts I and II only.)  
Church membership (Part III only).  
"Communion only," if named in communion certificate but failed to take qualifying oaths (Part III only).

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- Line type 3. Denomination of communion service (Part III only).

Location of church or congregation in which communion administered (Part III only).

- Line type 4. Clergyman administering communion (Part III only).

Witnesses to communion (Part III only).

Within each record in this volume, the names of the naturalized have been arranged alphabetically, though families have been kept together as units. Separate original records for which all items, except the data in the "type 2" lines, are identical have been combined into a single record.

All data in the denization records (Part I) were directly transcribed from the Maryland Archives volumes referenced. Modern spellings of the names of counties were substituted for variant forms.

Part II is a composite of information from the Maryland Archives volumes and Bacon's Laws of Maryland. The Archives' spellings were considered more reliable and were adopted here. The naturalization date for each record was taken as the day the private act was signed into law. Spellings of county names were modernized.

The naturalizations contained in Part III include all usable data from each original record. Each of the original records in the Provincial Court Judgments libers begins with a list of those persons naturalized at that Court session. Communion certificates, if recorded, follow, sometimes covering several folios. An original record which includes communion certificates concludes with a second listing of those naturalized.

The folios cited in the references in this volume are those on which the first list of naturalized persons appears and not those of the communion certificates. Spellings of names have been taken from the communion certificates, when available, to avoid the problems that English scribes sometimes experienced with non-English names. Unlabeled have been replaced by the original vowel followed by an "e". In some cases, more likely spellings have been suggested for dis-

torted, but recognizable names. (Isagar and Wrightsmore are probably Isagar and Ridenour.) A few names have been rearranged. (Turner, Christian Getson and Backer, Bernard Wherton have become Getson Danner, Christian and Wherton Backer, Bernard.) The fondness of some of the clergy for latinized versions of names has not been tampered with. Persons named in the communion certificates, but not in the list of the naturalized, have been given "communion only" designations. Communion witnesses' names were transcribed as faithfully as possible. Occasionally, however, the combination of poorly written German script and the distortion of the recording process precluded interpretation. A single hyphen in a name represents an undecipherable letter; three hyphens indicate a partially illegible name.

Questionable or implied information is repeated as it appears in the original, but is enclosed in parentheses. (A location or date of a communion certificate signature, but not necessarily of communion administration is bracketed. Likewise, dates on records which fail to maintain the chronological order of their recording are indicated with parentheses.)

Place-names have been reproduced just as they were originally recorded. "Town" or "County" was copied for entries mentioning Frederick and Baltimore if that clarification was available. The religious denomination called Baptist here is the German Baptist sect now known as the Church of the Brethren. Although occasionally called Unitas Fratrum here, the Brethren should not be confused with the Moravians who also bear that Latin title. The locations of the communions administered by Church of England rectors are cited by parish name. Place-names, clergy, and parish locations are identified in the Appendix.

In using these records and indexes it should be remembered that in German names leading T's, B's, and K's are sometimes found as D's, P's, and C's, respectively, and vice versa. Family names beginning with an S followed by a consonant may begin as Sh or Sch followed by the consonant. Phonetic variations of German spellings frequently appear here. A signature as a witness, if available, most accurately portrays the immigrant's spelling of his name.
