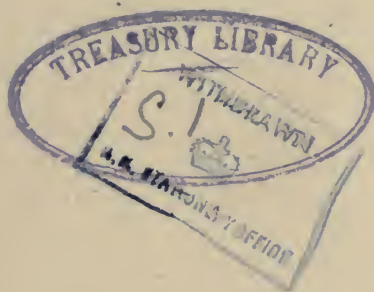


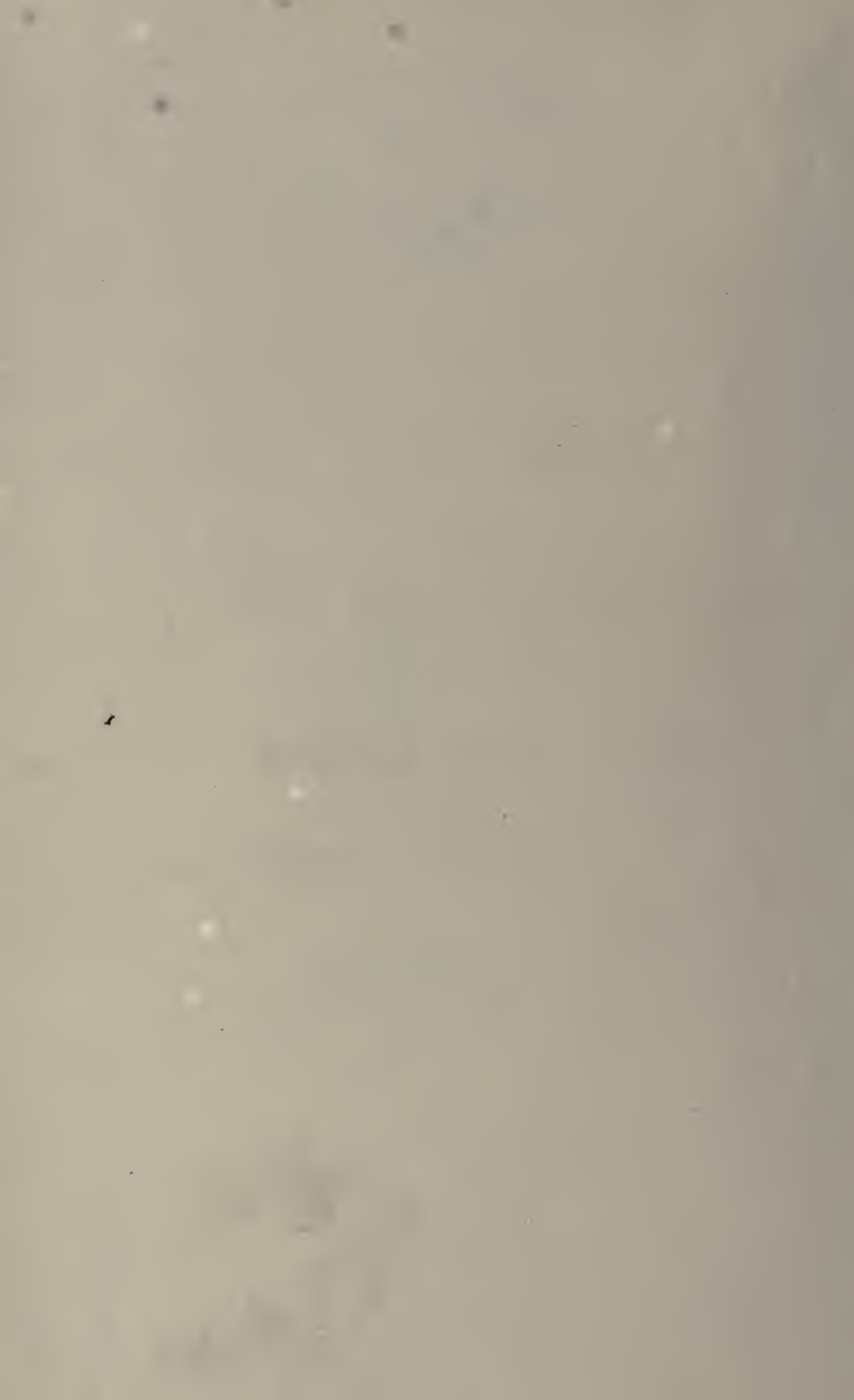

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Prefatory Note

THIS volume is the first of a series to be continued annually, recording, as far as possible, all publications relating to Wales and to the Celtic Peoples and Languages.

Considerable difficulty has been experienced in collecting the information, and there must be many omissions in the following list of publications for 1909.

It will be observed that Programmes, etc., of Eisteddfodau, Reports of Religious and other Institutions, and many similar minor publications are included. These will, some day, be of inestimable service, and even to-day they reflect the various activities, civil and religious, social and political, of the people of Wales. For example, the range of the Eisteddfod in Wales and beyond is graphically illustrated by the list of Eisteddfod programmes.

The fullest details available are given. In some cases it has been impossible to obtain replies to letters

asking for information. Sizes are given in millimetres, which can be converted to English measure by means of the scale diagram given on page viii.

It is hoped that future issues of this register will appear soon after the close of the year recorded. Authors, Publishers, and Printers are invited to co-operate in making the list complete by sending information relating to their publications to the Librarian, National Library of Wales, Aberystwyth.

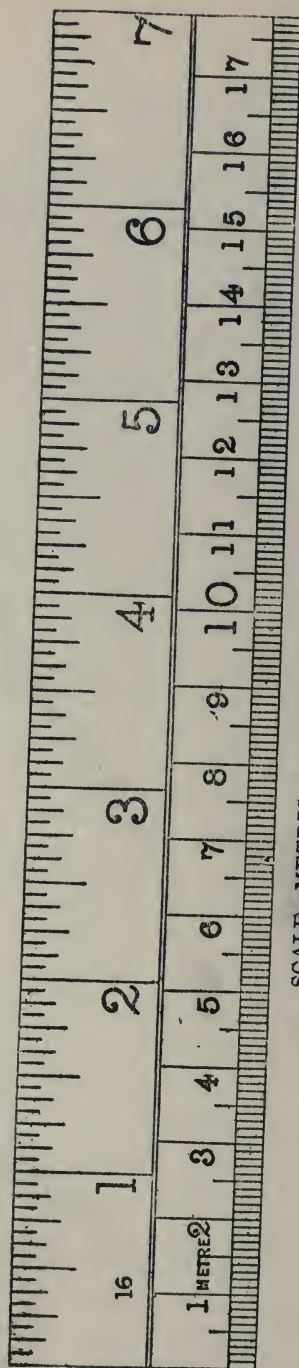

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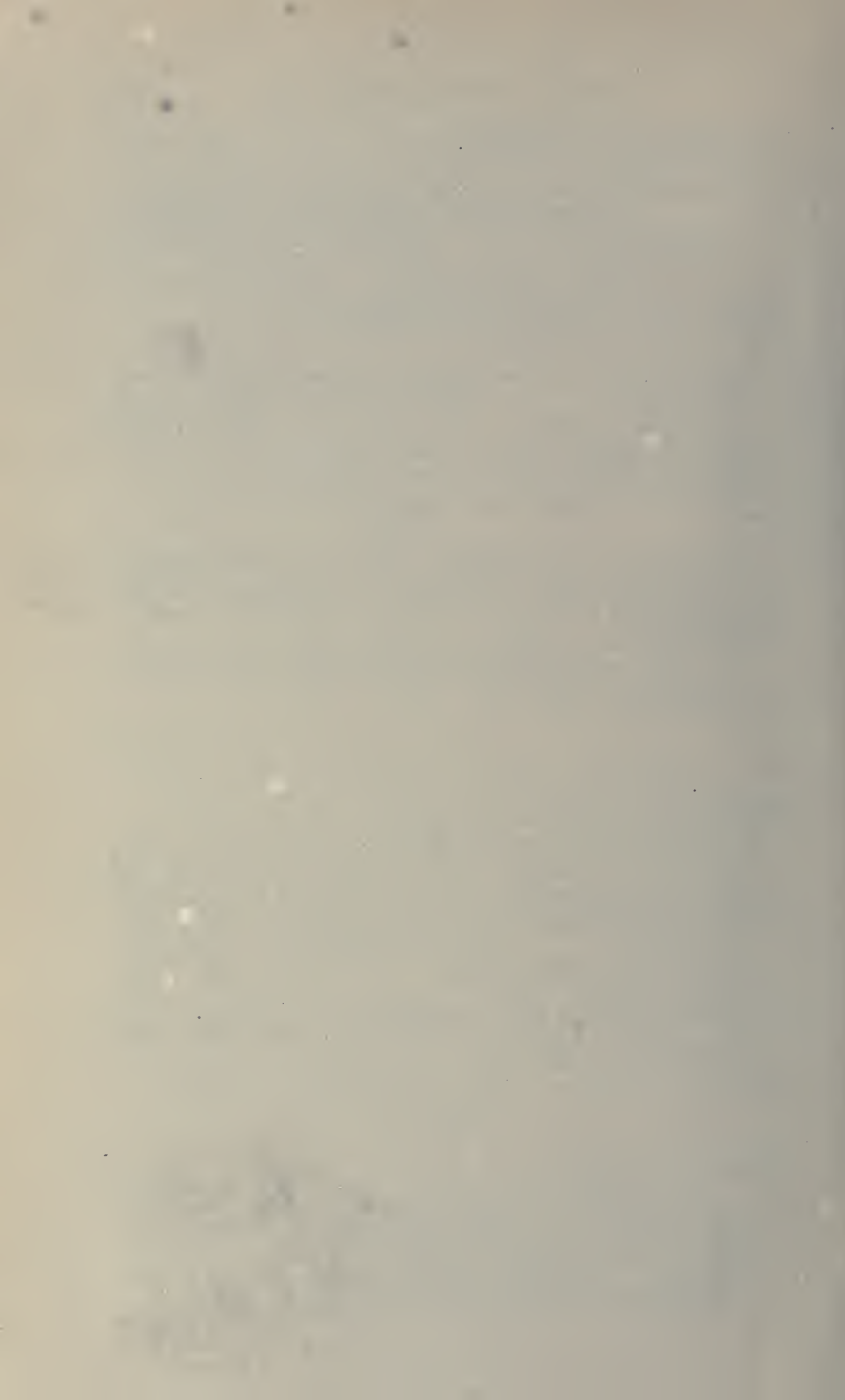
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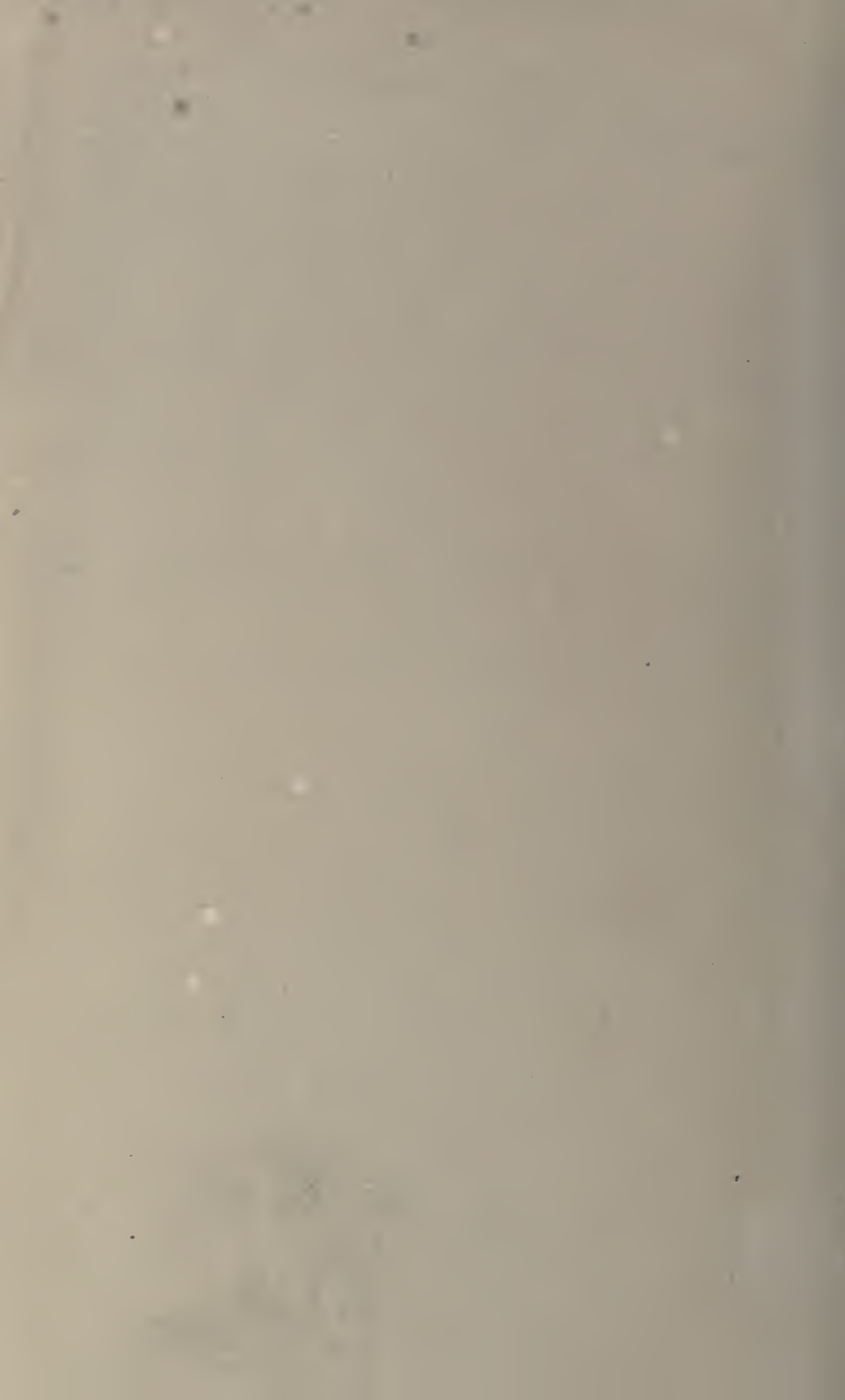
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
