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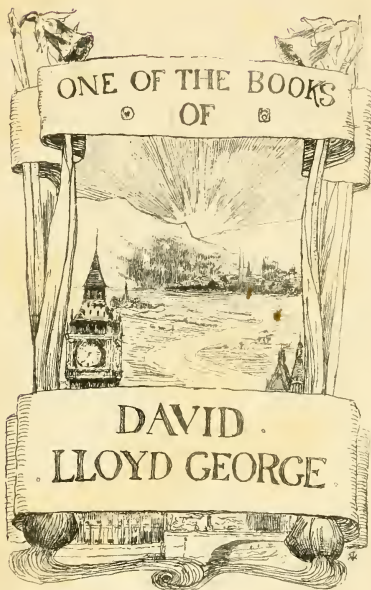

Prefatory Note

IN issuing the second volume of the "Bibliotheca Celtica," covering the publications for the year 1910, it is not necessary to add much to the note prefixed to the first volume.

The programmes, etc., of Eisteddfodau have not been fully catalogued as in the previous volume. This seems unnecessary. A list (much longer than that for 1909) of Eisteddfodau, of which records are in the National Library, is given on pp. 203—213. The list, still unfortunately not complete, is interesting, as it shows the wide range and popularity of the Eisteddfod, not only in Wales but in England and Abroad.

A list of newspapers and periodicals filed has been added, pp. 213—226. Many exclusively local periodicals, chiefly issued by religious bodies or in connection with social and philanthropic movements, are still wanting, and

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information as to these will be welcomed. A single number posted to the Librarian will enable the clue thus given to be followed up.

In spite of every effort, there is no doubt that many publications have escaped the vigilance of the officials, and information as to these will be welcomed.

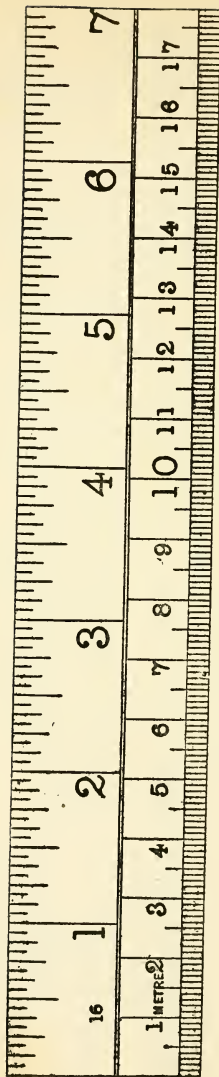
