Thanks are due to those who, by acting as correspondents in different localities, have supplied the particulars of many local publications which would otherwise have been missed.

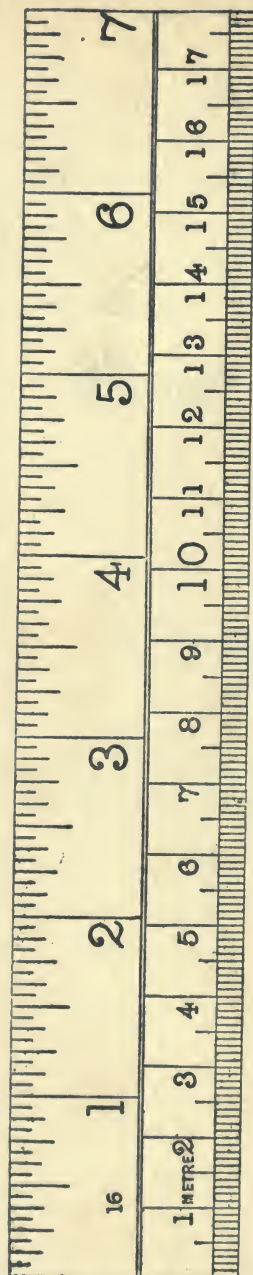
