Additional Information: John Belles (1781-1839) was the son of Henry and Mary Belles. The will of Henry Belles is recorded in Scott County, Kentucky, Will Book B, page 35, dated July, 1807., probated Dec., 1809. The will of Mary Bellas (or Bellows), widow of Henry Belles, is recorded in Fayette County, Kentucky, Will Book L, page 459, dated June 13, 1833, probated Sept., 1834. Dorcas Sanders, 2nd wife of John Belles, was the daughter of John Sanders (born Jan. 22, 1756; died Feb. 5, 1809, son of James and Sara Tully Sanders) and Sara Grant Sanders (born Jan. 25, 1759; died Mch. 29, 1814; daughter of William and Elizabeth Boone Grant). Dorcas Sanders married (1) John Snell, (2) John Belles, (3) Thomas Hawkins. Artemisia Tarlton Belles (born Feb. 10, 1832; died Oct. 7, 1904), daughter of John Belles and his 2nd wife, Dorcas Sanders Belles, married, Harrison County, Kentucky, Sept. 3, 1857, Thomas Veach Ashbrook (born Aug. 22, 1828; died Sept. 30, 1874), son of Aaron Ashbrook and Sara Steward Veach Ashbrook.
