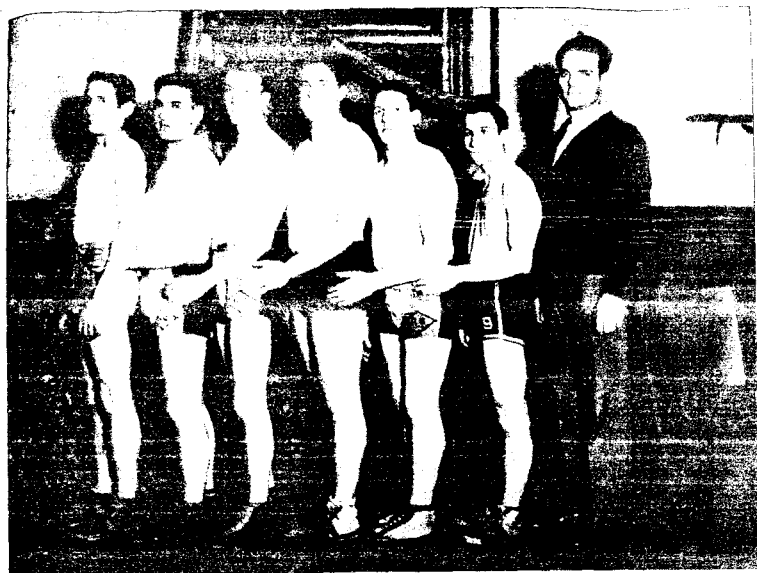

Wicker Family

I was born on Stone Coal Creek of Garrett, Kentucky. My father was John C. Wicker, my mother was Eva Hoover

Wicker, two sisters, Gladys and Greta Sue, three brothers, James (Jim), Vinnon, and Aaron. We four boys were all war veterans. Jim was in the Army, stationed in Europe during WWII, and wounded twice; I was in the Army, stationed in the South Pacific during WWII, and received one minor injury; Vinnon was in the Navy during the Korean

War; and Aaron was also in the Navy during the Vietnam War. Either of us were drafted, we volunteered. Our dad was so proud of us.

Jim, Gladys, and Aaron live in Jeffersonville, Montgomery County, Kentucky; Greta is deceased; Vinnon lives at Madison, Alabama; and I live at Wurtland, Greenup County, Kentucky.

We are all living on retirement now. Jim retired as a carpenter and worked at IBM in Lexington, Kentucky; Vinnon retired as a electronic technician; Aaron retired as a carpenter and the last few years he worked, he formed his own construction company; Gladys' husband, also, retired as a carpenter; and I retired as a construction superintendent.

Getting back to Garrett, I have often wondered about the children I knew then. Where did they all go? I know coal played out, and most went to Ohio, Indiana, and Michigan. I never went back after WWII because I had no intentions of working in the mines. I was happy in construction work. My last 20 years I worked for a company in Huntington, West Virginia, with steady employment. Eventually, I moved to Ashland and I enjoy it here.

The Wicker family in Floyd County, Kentucky, starts with Jesse Wicker, born about 1822 in Greene County, Tennessee. Jesse was in Floyd County in 1850 with his wife, Elizabeth Hays, and three children: Robert, born 1844; John, born 1848; and Mary, born 1849. By 1860 they had added four more children: Elizabeth, born 1851; Annanta, born November 7, 1857; Daniel, born January 2, 1859; Anna, born 1860; and William, born 1866.

Jesse and his family lived in and around Lackey in Knott County and up Right Beaver Creek to Four Mile Hollow. They lived by subsistence farming and timbering, as everyone did at that time. After the Civil War coal was starting to be mined in their area with mines at Garrett and Wayland. Most of the Wicker men became miners.

John Wicker, born 1846 and died February 12, 1917. He was the second child of Jesse. He married Rebecca Wallen December 13, 1867, and had: Amanda, born 1868; Lee, born 1870; and Ellen, born 1873. Rebecca died ca. 1874.

John married on March 23, 1876, Elizabeth Hunter and had: Bob; Bee; Wesley, born 1876; Alexander, born 1879; Marion, born 1882; Luce, born 1885; Ruthford, born 1887; and Poca, born 1890. Elizabeth died in 1890 during childbirth or shortly thereafter.

John married Artie Triplett October 28, 1890. They had: John C., born April 24, 1897, and died March 31, 1987; James P., born June 21, 1899,

and died December 24, 1918; Crit, born 1902; Rachel, born 1904; Pearly, born 1906; and Dolly, born 1908. During three marriages John fathered 15 children, being 61 years old when the last one was born. This in its self says a lot about the stamina and character of mountain-born people. Artie married a man 20 years her senior with six small children with one less than a year old, I don't think any woman today would even think of entering a marriage like this. Artie was born December 2, 1868, and died January 2, 1918.

The Wicker family still lives in the mountains of Eastern Kentucky and prosper, and probably will forever.

I think that her father should have had the name Flora Malicout put on the tombstone, so other people would know who was buried in that grave.

Nellie Laws, daughter of Mattison P. and Amanda (Moses) Laws, married Charlie Shelby.
