Was cashier of the Farmers Bank and the Somerset Deposit Bank of Somerset, Ky.; also Secretary of the Louisville and Indianapolis Railroad. m. in Frederick Co., Va., 14th Feb. 1820, his first cousin, Emily Bushrod TAYLOR, dau. of Bushrod and Martha Peyton (STUBBLEFIELD) TAYLOR, and lived in Winchester, Va., until 1830, when he removed to Fayette Co., Ky. After the death of his wife in 1857, he removed to Somerset, Ky.
