Lineage

ALEXANDER ROBINSON, the immigrant; *b.* in County of Armagh, near the city of Londonderry, Ireland, 1750; *d.* in Baltimore, Maryland, 9th August, 1845. Came to America in the latter part of the eighteenth century, and settled in Baltimore, Maryland. He was of the Irish branch of Rokeby ROBINSONS, Barons Rokeby, of Rokeby Park, Yorkshire, England. This family was descended from the ROBERTSONS, Barons Struan, of Perthshire, Scotland; *m.* (firstly) Priscilla LYLES, *b.* 1760; *d.* 7th July, 1790, widow of Robert BOOTH, and a sister of Dr. Richard LYLES, of Montgomery County, Maryland; *m.* (second) Miss PEALE, dau. of Charles Wilson and Rachel (BREWER) PEALE, and from this marriage came the Baltimore and St. Louis ROBINSONS, and from the first marriage the ROBINSONS of Louisville.
