 very Sick and but in perfect mind and memory thanks be
 given to God Calling to mind the mortality of my Body
 and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
 do make and ordain this my Last Will & Testament that is
 to say principally and first of all I Give and recommend
 my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it
 and my Body I commend to the earth to be buried in
 decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors
 nothing doubting but at the General resurrection I shall
 receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as
 touching such worldly estate where with it has pleased God to
 bless me in this life I give devise and dispose of the same
 as follows manors and farms first I Give and bequeath to
 Margaret my dear beloved wife all and singular the same
 and Tenements whereon I now Live during her life together
 with my small Horse & Farming Tools and all the rest
 of my movable Estate to be invested in my wife
 Margaret & Joseph Ritter whom I likewise constitute
 to be my sole Executors in this my last will & Testament
 after an appraisement of the Estate to pay off or
 Dispose of the same at their Discretion agreeable to the
 appraisement and after the Death of Margaret my wife
 and equal Division to be made amongst all my

Children and I solemnly aitterly declare as follows
 Disanna Oall and every other former Testaments by me
 made and executed by me in any wise informed
 written and leguallied ratifying and confirming this and
 no other to be my last will and Testament In
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
 of Decr 1805
