I was born in 1782

This my last will and Testament
 I Andrew Nuckolls of Barren County Ky being in
 the seventy fourth year of my age and being
 of sound mind and memory do hereby
 declare to divide my little property so as to
 make all my children equal with what they
 have had from me before having left a
 memorandum of what I have given each of
 them heretofore. I now divide the Balance of
 my property in the following order To take place
 at or after my death. The division to be executed
 by my son A. G. Nuckolls
 My eldest son Hazziah Nuckolls as he is
 in sentiment opposed to slavery I appoint
 that A. G. Nuckolls raise and pay him Hazziah
 Nuckolls Six Hundred Dollars out of the
 Property I leave in his hand to be paid in
 one year after my death or at any time
 as he shall see fit
 My eldest daughter Polly Huffman for
 her to have my share of the land my girl
 Ann for her and her children at or after
 my death, My second son James Nuckolls
 to have my share of land for him and
 his children at or after my death
 My second daughter Sarah Smith that
 her children have my two boys Calvin
 and George at or after my death My third
 daughter Susannah Pace that her children
 have my two boys Gabriel and Christopher
 at or after my death, My fourth daughter
 Martha Harrison that her three daughters now
 in Texas have seven hundred and fifty dol-
 -lars for the three as soon as it can be raised
 and sent to them safely after my death or as
 they come of age. And my third and youngest
 son Andrew B. Nuckolls it is my will that he
 shall have my land and farms on which I now
 live and all my stock all of my household
 and kitchen furniture all of my tools of all
 kinds and also my boys Hazziah and James

and my woman Fanny and her two youngest
 Children viz Betty and Albert with all of
 my papers and whatever may be found in
 my possession at the time of my death not
 otherwise disposed of for him to sell what part
 of this property he pleased to raise the money for his
 brother Ezekiah \$100.- and for his sister Martin's
 Children \$50.00 and to pay all my debts should
 there be any not settled and to bury me and pay
 all expenses but no funeral and of no course no funeral
 expenses. In this my will I think I have nearly
 equalized my children my son A. B. Nuckols may have
 some more than the others have had but he has
 a risk to run both in Property and expences with
 me and as I consider he has not been fully paid
 for his services heretofore perhaps I have divided
 as nearly equal as I can. It is my will that
 A. B. Nuckols my son execute this my last
 will and Testament concerning my Property
 and person all the above things to take place
 after my death. The within is all of my
 Will and Testament concerning of my Per-
 -son and effects of this world's Sub Testimony
 of which I set to my hand and seal this 21st
 of May 1852
