Thirdly, it is my desire that my stepmother Sarah Best & my two sisters Fanny Roberts & Elizabeth Best should be entitled to the whole of my real and personal property. If the above named three Legates could manage it so as to keep the Negro part of the property divided I would prefer it but if they cannot it is my wish that they said Negroes should be sold at twelve months credit and the Money divided between the last named Legates given under my hand in the presence of the two subscribing Witnesses David Logan James Dodd Junr
