my last Will and Testament revoking all other will
or Wills heretofore made and first I Give my body
to the Ground to be Buried at the discretion of my
Executors in Christian like manner
2nd I Give unto my beloved Wife Mary all
of my Estate both real and personal after my just Debt
or debts paid during her natural life and after her
Death then my Will and desire is that my land shall
go to my two Sons John and Benjamin all the one horse
and two to each of them if they can be spared and
the balance of my property to my four youngest daughters
namely Delila Lintha, Thewinto and Harbourn
Hocher I Give unto my Son Abel Hocher one horse and
two when he comes if it can be spared -

Also I Give to my sons John and Benjamin
Elizabeth Linthens two Dollars to each of them when
my Wife can spare it either in money or property
I Give unto my Son Turner a bond on James
Dunall for twenty Dollars, Paid to gether with the
Interest the said Dunall living in Bath County Ken-
tucky.

I do hereby appoint my friend Simon Lewis my Executor
of this my last Will and Testament In Testimony whereof

Balance of my Debt to be equally divided between myself
John Logsdon and my daughter Mary White

Item 4th It is my Will and desire that my son John
Logsdon should Administer on my Estate at my Death
In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
affixed my seal this eighteenth day of April in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen
