 in law and manner following. First it is my Will
 that all my just Dues be paid or satisfied secondly
 I will and bequeath unto Marget Bailey my Dear
 Beloved Wife a Contingible Dower and Custody to support
 her Dues or Prophets arising from my last Testament
 During her natural life or widowhood also I will unto
 the said Marget my Wife a Horse & Saddle by the Name
 of Justice for her own proper use I also I will
 and bequeath to my Dear Beloved Daughter Marget Bailey
 & Jane Bailey and my Grand Son William Bailey
 to be a comfortable support from the prophets arising
 from my Estate and I command them they come to the
 age of twenty one year or thereabouts then to be an and equal
 and fair Division of all the Land and Tenements to
 which I have any Right or Title between the said Marget
 Jane and William Bailey to them their Heirs and assigns
 for their own proper use. Excepting that part of
 my Land on which Daniel Hunt now lives to be sold
 of to said Daniel agreeable to a former Contract and
 designated as followeth. Beginning all the Mouth of
 the Branch that is in my Bottom field thence
 running up said Branch to the head of the hollow
 thence continuing on a straight line with the same
 to my Back Line which part of my Land above described
 with all its appurtenances I will and bequeath unto said
 Daniel Hunt his Heirs and assigns for their proper use
 forever. From said Will to my Beloved Daughter
 Martha Bailey a Horse Saddle and Cow that shall be
 put upon and Equality with them I give my
 other Daughters and lastly in all things in regard of
 all my Black Horses Cattle Sheep Hogs Waggon Farming
 Utensils Brand Notes money Household furniture
 I will shall be sold at public Sale and the money
 and Prophets arising from the same to be equally
 divided between the above named Daughters Marget
 Bailey Jane Bailey and my Grand Son William Bailey
 when they come to age of twenty one or thereabouts
 to as much as shall be necessary for the schooling
 or Educating said Children and lastly I do appoint
 my Trusty friends Daniel Hunt and Marget Bailey

my Wife whom I constitute and declare my only and
 Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament and I do
 hereby telling said Marget Bailey and Jane all and every
 other former Testament Wills Legacies and Executors by
 me in any way before this time named Marget Bailey
