Item I bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Shaddy all the tract of land whereon I now live including the mansion as well as other ~~houses~~ containing ninety seven acres by survey during her widowhood or natural life term with all my horse, hold and kitchen furniture except such articles as will hereafter name after my age, death or her widowhood shall end.

It is my will and desire that the above named tract of land shall be equally divided between my two sons (to wit) Benjamin S. Shaddy & William Shaddy according to quantity and quality after my wife's death.

Item It is my will and desire that my son William S. Shaddy shall have half of my crop cut said 1 clock and Case on Cherry Bush / Cyclus near white cut

Spain of trace & turning, place to him and his heirs forever. Item It is my will and desire that the following property to wit shall be equally divided between my two sons William and Benjamin a Sundry white cow It is my will and desire that my son Benjamin Shaddy shall have my shot gun of powder & horn forever. Item It is my will and desire that the residue of my household & kitchen furniture shall descend and be the property of my beloved wife Sarah Shaddy during her natural life ended at her death. If and the above the same shall be sold and equally divided between all my children. And finally I do nominate and appoint my son William S. Shaddy and my son in law Samuel S.
