In the name of God Amen I Edward Ballinger of the County of Barren & State of Kentucky being of sound mind & memory calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed unto all men once to die, do make constitute & ordain this my last will & testament that is to say after all my just debts are paid & funeral expenses are paid I give bequeath & dispose of my estate in the following manner & form to wit First I give unto my son William Ballinger two thousand dollars which sum is to be made up in cash & cash notes out of my said estate as circumstances may require, also the one half of my flock of Horns Cattle sheep & hogs with the one half of the household kitchen furniture plantation & farming utensils each of which articles he is to have the one half & in case my death should happen before the first day of May in any year to come I give unto my said son William the one half of the crop then growing on my farm or farms in case my death should happen before the first day of May in any year to come in that case I give unto him my said son William Ballinger the one half of the old crop that may then be in hand either in my Acre stack yards Smokehouse or in the fields, the best up, as his full share & legacy of my estate - Secondly I give and bequeath unto my son Edward Ballinger all the balance of my property a follows viz the tract of land wherein I now live containing two hundred acres, one other tract containing seventy five acres known by the name of Rankin. One other tract containing two hundred acres known by the name of Short quarter. One other tract containing one hundred acres known by the name of the Post Dick tract one other tract containing fourteen acres purchased of James Chapman also one other tract purchased of Coby Danks containing one hundred & twenty five acres with all my slaves namely my man Lewis & Dinah his wife and children namely Ellen & her child Logan Maranda Maria Julia America Duff Lot Alfred Emma & Richard Carter, also Henry & his wife Sarah & their children namely Allen Jacob Willie Phillis John Mary Eliza Oliver & Willie Henry with two other men slaves named Fleming & Wallis and the one half of my flock of Horns Cattle sheep & hogs also the one half of the household & kitchen furniture &c

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plantations tools & utensils also the one half of the growing
crop in case my death should happen after the first
day of May in any year to come in case my death should
happen before the first day of May in any year to come
in that said I give unto my said son Edward the one half
of the old crop that may be on hand at that time either
in the Cots stucky or stacked up the field or stored
in the stacks bound to my said son Edward Ballinger &
his heirs forever - And it is my further will & desire
that Commissioners be appointed by the County Court of
Barren to divide between my two children William
& Edward Ballinger all the above mentioned property
left to be divided and that he no sale made of any
of said property so left to be divided - Lastly I appoint
my son Edward Ballinger my sole executor of this my
last will and testament ratifying & confirming this
& no other to be my last will & testament. In witness

H. Bullock
Will

Whereas David Bullock of the City of Richmond
in the State Va by deed bearing date the 24 September
1827 conveyed certain lands lying on Shays Creek in
Barren County Ky to Thomas Thompson his heirs & assigns
forever upon special trust and confidence that the
undersigned Hannah Bullock wife of Edward Bullock
should occupy said lands and receive to her own use
and benefit the rents issues & profits there of during
her natural life over which her said husband was
to have no control or interest whatever, with power
to her if she survived her said husband of disposing
of said land by will to any other children except
his son David Cobb I Edward & their daughter Cath-
arine Roy or their descendants as by references to said
deed will more fully appear - Now I Hannah Bullock
of the County of Barren & State of Ky residing on said
lands and my husband being dead in execution of
the power & authority vested in me by said deed do hereby
will & bequeath parcels of the said tract of land to the
several persons hereafter named in manner & form
following to wit - 1st I will & bequeath to my son
John W Bullock one hundred and twenty acres of
land be the same more or less including the farm
on which Thompson Wellborn now lives beginning at
Walnut & Sugar trees between the Thompsons well roads
& Shads Creek on the original and land running thence
N 4 E 87 poles to white Oak on Shads Creek thence S
2 E 10 40 poles to a stake thence S 44 W 144 poles to two
horn beams on Shads Creek thence down said creek
with its meanders to the point of the bluff to a big cypress
tree & white Walnut on the bank of said creek
thence S 44 W 144 poles to two hackberries on the bank
