In obedience to an order of the Barren County Court made at their December Inventory Term 1827 the Sheriff of the County of said makes the following Report & Findings that he took into his possession one horse one Bureau one Bed & bedstead one Drawing Knife & one pair of pinners & one shoe hammer which was all the personal estate that could be found belonging to Francis Enoch Dec and that he made sale of said property according to Law & the order of the Court of said on the 11th day of January 1828 in a credit of twelve months and Jane Finley became the purchaser of the horse & Bureau and Bed & Bedstead at the sum of thirty dollars and Joshua Wheeler became the purchaser of the pinners & hammer at seventy five cents and Samuel Whiting became the purchaser of the drawing Knife at fifty five cents the whole sum amounting to the sum of \$31 35 cents & took home of the several purchasers which are herewith returned to the Court
