

In the name of God amen. I Joseph Henderson of the County of Barren and State of Kentucky being of sound mind but frail in my body and knowing the uncertainty of time, and the certainty of death, and not knowing how long that event may take place - do hereby Ordain and establish this to be my last Will and Testament revoking all others whatsoever heretofore made by me.

Item first: It is my Will and wish when I die that all my past debts and funeral expenses be paid, the debts being few in number and not of much magnitude. Except those hereinafter more specially referred to.

Item second: I give and bequeath unto each of my brother Maadon Henderson's children which may be now alive (except his son James Henderson to whom it is understood no part of my property is to go) the sum of fifty dollars, each to them their heirs and legal representatives forever, which money is to be paid to them respectively by my Executors hereinafter named and appointed.

Item 3<sup>d</sup>: I also give and bequeath unto each of my brother Robert Henderson's children which may be now alive (except his son William Henderson to whom it is understood no part of my property is to go) the sum of fifty dollars each to them their heirs and legal representatives forever, which money is to be paid in like manner, by my Executors.

Item 4<sup>th</sup>: I give and bequeath unto <sup>daughter of the late John Hagerwood</sup> Eliza Hagerwood, who is at this time living in my family all the household and kitchen furniture which I may leave together with a horse called whip and a saddle and bridle.

Item 5<sup>th</sup>: Whereas my Nephews Hagekiah Bellworell and James Murrell sons of Col. Samuel Murrell of Barren County have much befriended me in advancing me money, and furnishing myself and family with many articles which they needed from time to time, and it is my desire to make them due return and compensation therefor it is therefore my Will and Wish that they do have and take all my property and estate, including land slaves and property of whatsoever kind which may be left, after the discharge of the debts and legacies, and bequests heretofore mentioned, to them respectively their heirs and assigns forever, as tenants in common, and I do moreover hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said Nephews Hagekiah P. Murrell and James Murrell my Executors with full power and authority to carry into effect this my last will and testament according to the true intent and meaning thereof.

Item 6<sup>th</sup>: Item It is my Will and wish that this Will is not to take effect until the death of my beloved wife Jenny Henderson, in case she should survive me, but that she shall enjoy the free use and occupation of all my estate, and the profits arising therefrom during her life.

In Testimony whereof I have hereunto I have signed my name with my own hand and affixed my seal, the 24<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Twenty Eight, Joseph Henderson.
