Secondly it is my Will and desire that my Old Servant Mary and her sucking child and my small slave Delah shall be and are hereby Bequeathed unto my beloved Wife during her life time and at her Decease the afore said slave and child shall be and they are hereby Bequeathed unto my son Edmund White and it is my Desire that all my household furniture together with my present stock of cattle and one half of my stock of Hogs shall remain the property of my Wife during her life time and at her Decease to be with their issue the property of my son Edmund White and it is my Desire that my Servant Mary and my slave Delah shall be sold to pay my just Debts and it is further my Desire that my small house called Fishers should remain on my farm as a Work house between my Wife and my son Edmund White during my Wife's lifetime and at her Decease to be the property of my afore said son Edmund White and it further my Wish and desire that my boy John Bell and my horse Jim and one Bay horse named and one cow & calf known by the name of Betty cow & calf shall and they are hereby Given and Bequeathed by me

her lifetime and at her Decease to be with their heirs and the property
of my son Edmund White and it is my Desire that my Servant Mary
