 2nd I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Susanna Jones a Negro Girl named Diley and her increase
 3rd I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Curbank a Negro Girl named Fanny and her Increase which she has by 1st I Give and Bequeath to my son Jacob White one hundred and twenty two acres of land be the same more or less agreeable to a dividing line now standing which includes the same on the South end of the tract I now live on also one Negro Girl named Anne and her increase present and one hundred ^{dollars} after my wifes Death or marriage
 5th I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Martha Kellaway a Negro Girl named Mary and her increase which she has by 6th I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Polly Glass Brook a Negro Girl named Judith & her increase which she has by 7th I Give and Bequeath to my son Simon White a Negro Boy named Solomon also one hundred Dollars & the same hundred acres of land remaining when I now live with all the improvement thereon after my wifes Death or marriage which she is to have during her natural life or widowhood
 8th I Give & Bequeath to my Daughter Rebecca White a Negro Girl named Cindy and her increase one Red & Furniture & a Horse saddle & Bridle to be worth one hundred Dollars
 9th I desire that all rest of my Estate both real & personal of what nature soever it may be not herein before particularly disposed of I desire to be sold and after my just Debt & funeral expenses are paid the balance to be equally divided among my several Children herein before named which I Give to them and their heirs forever
 And Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my wife Elizabeth White & my son Jacob White & Simon White Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all others or former Wills
