 thereunto and a James and Robert my two sons and Jean my
 daughter I bequeath unto each of them ten shillings a piece I
 do appoint my son John Executor of this my last Will and Testament
 I do also hereby declare that any Will or Will made by me before
 this date is made void and of none effect and that this only is to
 be taken for my last Will and Testament given under my hand
 and seal this 30th day of July one thousand Eight hundred and
 one, signed sealed
