and they believe that he was in his proper sense and memory and
thereupon the said Writing was ordered to be recorded as the last
last Will and Testament of the said Benjamin Williams Esq.

In the name of God Amen I Richard Hoggson
Senior of the County of Barren and State of Kentucky being
old and full of age but of sound mind and memory thanks
to God for the same do make and ordain this my last Will
and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills & Testaments
made by me First I commend my soul to God who gave it not
describing but at the general description I shall receive the same
from the hands of the same benevolent Giver and my body to
the dust from whence it was taken to be buried in a decent
Christian life manner at the discretion of my Executors and as
to what worldly goods and effects as it has been pleased a kind
providence to bestow on me I will and dispose of in the following
manner First I leave unto my beloved wife Mary Hoggson
for and during her Widowhood all my Estate both real and personal
and after her Death or death I do dispose of it in the
following manner
After the marriage or death of my said Wife I Will and bequeath
that all my Estate be equally divided between all
