Exam. Here, the Will and desires is after my funeral expenses that all my

Here I give mine and bequeath unto my daughter, she with one
Negro woman named Sam to be her hour forever

them I lend to my daughter Lemima Douglass One Negro has
name (old) Abraham until her daughter Rachel becomes of
lawful age at which time I wish the said Negro to be sold
and equally divided between the four daughters of Lemima
Douglass (namely Lemima, Polly, Tabitha & Rachel & their heirs & assigns

And I lend to my daughter Peggy Benick one Negro Man named
Lucas until her daughter Mrs. becomes of lawful age at which
time I wish the said Negro to be sold and equally divided between
three of her daughters namely Rachel, Polly and Abby, to have
their heirs forever —

Item I give devise and bequeath to my daughter Polly Ball's one
Negro Woman namedoley and one hundred dollars in
cash to her, her heirs forever.

Now I give devise and bequeath unto my Grand Son William Smith
(son of Rachel) one nigg^r boy nam'd York to him his heirs forever

Item I give devise and bequeath to my three grand daughters Betts Smith Jenny Fox & Massena Smith three Negroes namely Moll Jenny and Lucy to them their heirs forever. Provided they can not agree in the division themselves I wish them to chuse three more of our race to make the division.

Then I give a shawl and beneath to my Grand daughter Rachel Wood
 in one feather Bed and furniture to her her heirs forever
