 glass to be sold at twelve months credit by my Executor here-
 after named and out of the money arising from such sale forty
 pounds to be paid unto my Daughter Mary Page which sum I
 give as a legacy out of my estate 5th The Balance of
 money that may remain after paying the said legacies & all my
 Just Debts to be divided into three equal parts one of which
 I give unto the Surviving Children of my Daughter Ann
 Hunter one other third part I give unto the Surviving

Children of my Daughter Eliza, Davenport the remaining
 this part together with my large Bible I looking glass
 before mentioned I have unto my Daughter Fanny Harrison
 to her & her heirs forever And lastly I do hereby Con-
 tinue & appoint my Son Samuel Samuel Executor of this
 my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all former Wills
 or Testaments by me heretofore made In Witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this thirty
