Do it know that on the 10th day of July 1822 at John W
Linden of the County of Barren & State of Kentucky has made
my last will and testament that is to say
I will that all my just debts be paid
I will that all my lands be sold on one two and three
years credit
I will that all the rest of my estate be sold except such
as I have devised I will that the negroes be sold but for the
maintenance of my Daughter Mary till she come to the age
of eight years old I do wish the Negroes not to be sold
in no town whatever
If my wife sister Rebecca Jones takes my youngest child
she is to have both my Negroes till she child comes to be eight
years old and also she is to have my wife Marys two
and at the age of eight years the Negroes is to be sold out
as above directed and in case that she does not take them
I will that they be sold at the end of the eight years
I will that the monies now in my possession or a gain from
sale or higher as when he collected and earned but on future
all the children comes of age & I will that all my children
Andrew & James Brumley & William & Mary & James have
a equal part of all my estate and yet the two administrators
or execution of this my last will and testament I appoint my friend
Sam Chambers as Lewis Parker one of the two my executor
executors in this my last will and testament I do wish
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the present day
