James & Co. who returned to court and ordered to be sworn.

It is known that on the 13th day of July 1822 I John D.
founder of the county of Barren & State of Kentucky have made
my last will and testament that is to say
I do will that all my lands be sold on one two and three
years time
I do will that all the rest of my estate be sold excepted
the negroes I do will that the negroes be hired out for the
maintenance of my Daughter Patsy till she come to the age
of Eight years old I do wish the Negroes not to be hired
in no town whatever
If my Wife Sister Rebecca Jones takes my youngest child
she is to have both my Negroes till she child comes to be Eight
Years old and also she is to have my wife's wearing dress
and at the age of eight years the Negroes is to be hired out
as above directed and in case that she does not become married
I do will that she be sold at the age of the eight years
I will that the monies now in my possession or arising from
sales or higher so much be collected and paid out on interest
till the child comes of age I will that all my children
Andrew & James & William & John & Mary & James have
a equal part of all my estate and for the better administration
of the same of this my last will and testament I appoint my friend
Samuel Chambers or Lewis Thomas one of the two my faithful
Executors in the my last will and testament I do wish
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and the seal of my
this day and date above written
