and memory knowing that it appointed one for all men
to die do make this my last Will and Testament in manner & form
as follows First I Give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Phoebe
Lyon during her natural life all my Personal Estate consisting of
Household & Kitchen Furniture Plantations Utensils, Stock of all kinds
and my Haggow for her to tend or dispose of as she may think proper during
her natural life 2^d I Give unto my beloved Wife during her natural
life the Plantation I now live on for her to have till or rented out
as she may think proper 3^d I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter
Sally Howbridge to her and her heirs or assigns forever at the death
of my Wife the land I now live on consisting of one hundred & thirty seven
her little to commence as said before at the death of my Wife
4th I Give and bequeath unto Pleasant May and my Daughter Polly
his Wife to them and their heirs forever a Tract of Land containing
one hundred Acres it being the same Land once sold to Abraham
Adams bounded by the same lines as was run for said Adams.
5th I Give and bequeath unto Pleasant May and my Daughter Polly
his Wife to them and their heirs forever another Tract of Land con-
taining twelve Acres Extent and Surveyed in my own name
and adjoining the former one hundred Acres
6th It is my desire that all of my personal property which may
remain at the death of my Wife be Equally Divided between my
two Daughters namely Sally Howbridge & Polly May, to be Equally
enjoyed by them and their heirs forever
7th I constitute and appoint my Daughter Sally Howbridge his
Executive of this my last Will & Testament and my desire is that
she enter Executive thereon immediately after the proof of this
my last Will in Court without giving Bond & Security
8th It is my desire, that my Executor above named see to and
discharge all my debts and claims all debts that may be due to me
9th I hereby revoke all other Wills that may have been made by
me and Declare this as my last Will & Testament Given
under my hand and seal the 26th day of April 1818
