All the commissioners appointed by the County Court of
 Barren to settle the estate of Daniel Turner dec'd and to settle
 the estate of Daniel Turner dec'd her right of dower in the lands and personal
 property of the said Isaac dec'd also to allot and assign to
 each of the heirs and representatives of the said Isaac dec'd
 their respective parts of the estate have this day agreed
 the premises and have ascertained by valuation that
 the slaves belonging to said estate amount to \$8123.
 so and an estimation of a settlement made by the
 commissioners appointed by the said Court to settle
 with Thomas Mann administrator of the said estate
 estate that there is in the hands of the said adm^r the
 sum of two thousand six hundred and eighty Dollars
 sixty nine and three fourth cents which being amount
 to \$2689.75 out of which deduct \$5.98 for clerk's
 tickets and \$100 allowed Isaac Winsley for taking care of
 three old negroes which being taken from the aggregate
 amount leaves a balance of \$2583.77 out of which
 we have allotted to Isaac Winsley widow the sum of
 \$198.37 to which add \$100 for taking care of the
 negroes as above stated and it makes the sum of \$2683.77
 which was paid over to her in the following manner
 one negro man with at \$370 Polly \$160 Major \$110
 and Labor 3, also paid by the estate \$1123.87 & cents
 in the said Isaac Winsley's hands and \$21.46 in Thomas
 Winsley's Bond and interest \$13.22 for Isaac Turner's
 and interest and \$4 for the hire of 3 old negroes
 which makes the sum of \$1953.19 and leaves a
 balance due the said Isaac Winsley \$56.37
 And we have also allotted to the said Isaac Winsley
 the commission House together with 86 acres of land
