Met agreeable to adjournment and E. Haydon Dudley Rountree & Jos. W. Willinger being present proceeded to business first to adjust and settle the accounts of the personal Estate as per accounts filed & some proceeds to make the division and allotments of said notes and lands as per acc^{ts} filed then the following notes & cash - viz Mosey Junior for two hundred dollars Lowry Bishops note for eighty five dollars now in the hands of R. Underwood for collection and Paul Bonds Receipt for collection the balance on it being one hundred and twenty two fifty seven cents the Credits on said Receipt of Henry Perkins and Mahlow Hale as Involunt together with Elizabeth Macey's Receipt not admitted were placed in the hands of Elijah Haydon administrator of the said Estate for the settlement of future debts and should be be not sufficient to the payment of said debts we have attested that the note of Hicks and of \$500 now in the hands of Joseph R. Underwood for collection be applied to fill up the deficiency of any out of equal proportions of the attolment under which we have placed in the hands of said Haydon all the Patents & P. & Co. certificates & Receipts & other papers which appear to be of no account now before us and which by their face we are unable to appropriate to any use given under our hands this 16th Septer 1821
