deposition of my mortal body must soon take place
and wishing to make a just distribution of such earthly
estate with which the Almighty Father of the Universe
hath been pleased to bless me with do hereby make
ordains & publish my last will & testament in the
manner & form following to-wit - My will & desire is
that all my just debts be speedily paid and my
funeral expenses defrayed. And as I have heretofore
liberally provided for my two children Sophia &
Lawrence and Achilles, I Galtwood the two children
I had by my first wife, I will now of course in
order to do justice to my present wife & the children
I have now or may hereafter have by her, only leave
to my daughter Sophia and my son Achilles but
a small portion of my estate to-wit. my will & desire
is that my executor pay my said son one hundred
dollars in money out my estate and no more as his
full part of my estate. And that said executor pay
in money of my estate five dollars to my said daughter
Sophia & Lawrence and no more in full of her part
of my estate - And my will and desire further is
that my beloved wife Polly Galtwood shall have
and enjoy one third of all of my estate both real
and personal during her life only and that then that
third and all the remainder of my said estate shall
be equally divided between all the children I now
have or may hereafter have by my dear & beloved wife
Polly Galtwood aforesaid, and that if the should
survive me and marry again and have a child
or children by any other man or man that that child
or children shall not have any part of my estate
and I wish that my said property shall not be sold
but divided without if practicable, and if it should
be deemed expedient to sell the same it may be done
without division of thought here - And I do hereby appoint
my beloved wife aforesaid my executor to this my last
will and testament hereby declaring & publishing this
as my last will & testament and I do hereby revoke

and annuls all others made by me since under
my hand & seal the 9th day of February in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty three

also all my chickens - the remainder of my estate
both real and personal I wish to be sold by my
executor herein after named giving such credits as
they may think advisable and then the whole of
what may come into the hands of my executor to be
after paying my just debts, equally divided amongst
my two children after giving one seventh to my grand
children the descendants of my daughter Lucy Williams
the six children to which I give the remainder after
dividing one seventh equally amongst my above named
grand children, one Peggy, David, Betsy, Wooten,
David Smith, Elizabeth, Chickarison, Sally, Wilhelms
and Mildred Smith - My will & desire is that part
of my estate hereby devised to my daughter Barbary
Wooten is expressly my desire should remain in the
hand & possession of James Nickolds and under his
