

42 I am which said Negro Boy and are now in his possession and also my tract of Land as mentioned in the first Item Item I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Lucy Bush and her heirs forever one Negro Boy named Williams and one Negro Girl by the name of Nancy and her future increase also one Feather Bed and furniture which said Negroes and Bed are now in her possession My Will and Desire further is that if any of my Children above mentioned should die without lawful issue of their Body that in that case all such Legacy as is hereby given shall ^{be} divided again revert back to my Estate and be equally divided amongst those that survive or their Heirs Lastly I do hereby appoint my two sons Thomas Grubbs and Mary D H Grubbs and my friend Hardin Davis Executors of this my last Will and Testament And further my will and Desire is that my Estate shall not be appraised In Missouri whereof I have heretofore set my hand and seal this 15th day of July 1818
