among my Children in manner and for as following To wit

- 1st I Give Benjamin Say three Dollars
 - 2nd I Give to Abraham Crute fifty Acres of Land It being
the tract of Land whereon he now lives to him and his heirs forever
 - 3rd I Give to George Mill helms fifty Acres of Land It being
the tract of Land whereon he now lives to him and his heirs forever
 - 4th I Give to John Collanton one Section of Land he now claims
also one cow and calf
 - 5th I Give to Jacob Collanton
one Section of Land that he now claims also one cow and calf
 - 6th I Give to Joseph Collanton one Section of Land he now claims also one
cow and calf
 - 7th It is my wish and desire that my Executors
hereafter named would out of my Estate Give Elizabeth Collanton
May Collanton and Say Collanton a share of Horses each that
shall be equal in value to those given to their Brothers or
other property to that amount and also each of them to have one
cow and calf
 - 8th All the rest of my Estate both real
and personal of what soever nature or kind soever it may be not
herein particularly disposed of I desire may be equally divided
among my several Children which I Give to them and their heirs forever
- And I fully do hereby constitute and appoint my wife
Elizabeth Howards^{shall} and my friends Messrs. Cox Executors
of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other
or former wills or Testaments by me heretofore made
