I William Bell being perfectly in my senses do make my last Will and Testament. In the first place I wish all my just debts to be paid. In the next place if William Henry Bell should ever come forward to claim any part of my Estate it is my desire that he shall have two Dollars in the hands of

38 Chaplinton on Big Barren River also four hundred dollars in cash it is my wish that he shall have the above named property and cash at the age of 18 years old but should he not claim it is to go to the other Division. Thirdly, it is my desire that my stepmother Sarah Best & my two sisters Fanny Roberts & Elizabeth Best should be entitled to the whole of my real and personal property. If the above named three Legates could manage it so as to keep the Negro part of the property divided I would prefer it but if they cannot it is my wish that they said Negroes should be sold at twelve months credit and the Money divided between the last named Legates given under my hand in the presence of the two subscribing Witnesses David Logan James Dodd Junr
