I will that the monies now in my possession or arising from sales or higher so much be collected and paid out on interest all the children comes of age I will that all my children Andrew & James & William & John & Mary & James have a equal part of all my estate and for the time administration or execution of this my last will and testament I appoint my friend James Chambers or Lewis Thomas one of the two my faithful Executors in the my last will and testament I do wish that whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 13<sup>th</sup> day of July 1822 at Boone Station
