aintenance of my Daughter Lucy till she come to the age  
of Eight Years old & so much the Negroes not to be hired  
in no Town whatever

4th If my Wifes Sister the bech Rogers takes my property this  
she is to have both my Negroes till she shall come to be eight  
Years old and also she is to have my Wifes Waving Cow  
and at the<sup>nd</sup> the eight years the Negroes are to be hired out  
as above directed and in case that she do not breed no more  
I Will that she be sold at the end of the eight years

5th I will that the monies now in my possession & a sum from  
sails or higher as will be collected and placed in trust  
till the Children come of age & Will that all my Children  
Andrew & James Penns & Rufus & Lucy Lander have  
a equal part of all my estate and for the time administration  
or Execution of this my Last Will and Testament I appoint my friend  
Sam<sup>r</sup> Chambers or his higher one of the two my lawful  
Executor in this my Last will and Testament & witness  
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the present day of  
this day and date above written John B Johnson 22<sup>nd</sup>
