Martin Button of the County of Barren and State
of Kentucky being of Sound mind and memory and
considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory
life do therefore Make certain publish and declare
this to be my last will and Testament. That is to
say first after all my lawful debts are paid and
discharged I give the residue of my estate real and personal
to my beloved wife Mary Jane the one third of my
Land including the dwelling House her life time and
then it is to be returned to my children. I also give
to my wife a certain Negro Girl named Mary
and her child Isaac and at my wife's death
the said Negro and the girl in case if any is to
return to my children I also give to my wife one
Horse and she is to take choice of my Horses except
my Stable Horse I also give to my wife two of my
best cows & calves two of my best beds furniture and
stools and my best Bureau and one year provision
I give to my Son James H. H. a certain Negro Boy
named John so he to be valued and two beds fur-
niture and two bed stools. I give to my Son Mar-
tin H. a certain Negro Girl named Ann
so she to be valued. I also give my best fur-
niture and two bed stools, also I give him one
Black Colt named doctor I give to my
