I Samuel Lane do hereby make my will & testament in manner & form following that is to say.

First I give to my daughter Margaret an equal share of all of my estate after my death

Second I give to my daughter Polly an equal share of all my estate after my death

Third I give to my daughter Jane King an equal share of all my estate after my death

Fourth I give to my son John an equal share of all my estate after my death

Fifth I give to my daughter Fanny ten dollars after my death

Sixth I give to my daughter Elizabeth an equal part of all my estate, after my death & then to heirs & out of the estate fifty dollars to remain in the hand of the administrator to be used as she needs it by the administrator

Seventh I give to my son Samuel an equal part of all my estate after my death.

Eighth I give to my daughter America an equal share of all my estate after my death

Ninth I give to my son Henry an equal share of all my estate after my death & I want his part of the land laid off adjoining the land I sell him

I give to them their heirs executors administrators & assigns forever. And lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my son Henry executor of this my last will & testament hereby revoking all other or former wills or testaments by me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 3rd day of September 1867 signed sealed published

Alexander Lock's will

In the name of God Amen. I Alexander Lock of the County of Bell & State of Kentucky do make ordain & publish the following as my last will & testament hereby revoking & annulling all former & other wills by me heretofore made. I give & devise to my wife during her life the use & benefit of the building and a sufficiency of land around for her sustenance admitting the two children to wit Abraham & Elizabeth Lock to enjoy the same as a home whilst they stay single. I further give my wife the Chestnut Sorrel mare & one third of my cattle with the exception of my work cattle; also one third of my sheep one clock her life time & said said one third of the kitchen furniture and a sufficiency of the growing crop on hand at my death together with all the poultry & other fowls I should be in possession of at my death.

2nd I will to my son Abraham all the land in the following boundary beginning at two Chestnut Oaks & Sourwood a corner to a ~~Survey~~ hundred acre survey made in the name of Wm Burns standing on the top of the ridge that divides the two first right hand forks of the Kittle Island; Thence running a straight line to the upper end of the deadwood bottom above the mud lick; Thence crossing the branch running up the Spur a South west Course to the top of the Spur that is between the main right hand forks of the wolf hollow; Thence running up the ridge to B A Rice line. Thence running with said Rice line to the top of the ridge dividing the east & west fork of the Kittle island. Thence running down the ridge a South east Course to the graveyard where the road turns down to the west fork; Thence down said fork to the mouth; Thence down the main branch to the right hand forks of Straight Creek; Thence up the Creek to a maple & Spruce Pine near the meeting house; Thence running with the line between my land & Isaac S. Horns to the top of rocky face; Thence with said rocky face keeping on the main top to the line of a 100 acre Survey made in the name of Wm Burns; Thence with the said line to the Beginning which includes my wife's dower which she is to have the use profits & benefits and proceeds during her life which after her death is to pass to my son Abraham.

I also give to my son Abraham my young bay mare, one third of the sheep & cattle excepting my work cattle and all my mechanics tools I have my farming tools to the use & benefit of the family. Also I will my son one third of the kitchen furniture and one rifle gun also one third of the effects not mentioned or disposed of.

3rd I will to my daughter Elizabeth Lock the land that lies on the main fork of the Kittle island. Beginning at two Chestnut Oaks & Sourwood on the ridge at or near the head of the right hand forks of the Kittle island branch Thence running with the line of my son Abraham Lock crossing the branch & following the same to the top of the ridge unto B A Rice line; Thence running with
