 take care of me the Remainder of my
 days on earth my will further is that
 Martha J Campbell have my nurse to be
 retained in the family and not to be sold
 at any time, This gift to be as a set off
 against my funeral expenses, it is my Request
 that funerals be conducted at my grave
 giving my name in full with my own
