I also will my daughter Eliza Jane Lock one black colt
one third of the cattle & sheep except the work cattle, two beds
& furniture to the same, one bed sled & one third of the kitchen
furniture, also one third of all other matters not disposed of.

I will my grandson Lawrence K Rice one hundred acres of land being
a one hundred acre survey made by Wm Burns known as the mill
place Beginning on two chestnut oaks & Sourwood, thence running
with the call of said Patton round back to the Beginning

I desire that my work cattle be sold on a credit of six months the
purchaser giving bond & approved security & the proceeds of the sale to
go to settle any just claim that should be against me;

Lastly & in conclusion I appoint my friends Nelson Durham &
Wm Hendrickson my executors to this my last will & testament
whereunto I have set my hand this 29th day of July 1873

the certainty of death being by the best informa-
tion aged in the present date 1873. 56 years
old get of a sound mind and good
memory do make my last will & testament
in the manner & form following to wit I
term the 1st I do will & bequeath unto my
beloved wife Sarah Goodin all my land
& property during her natural life

Item 2nd I do will & bequeath to my eldest
daughter China Jane Wilson \$100 one hundred
dollars to be paid out of my estate

Item 3rd I also will & bequeath to my eldest
son Thomas D. Goodin one hundred dollars
to be paid out of my estate

Item 4th it is my will & desire that my
daughter Sarah A. Goodin and my three
sons to wit Ebenezer Goodin Charles Goodin
& George Goodin to share the land equally at the
death of my wife Sarah Goodin all except
the portion that will be hereafter mention-
ed for my youngest son Hardin G. Goodin

Item 5th I do will & bequeath to my youngest
son Hardin G. Goodin all the land from the
hollow known as the board tree hollow to the
condition at line between John Goodin Jr &
Hardin Goodin W. B. that I desire John
Goodin Jr to settle all my just debts being that
said Goodin is an agent to collect debts for me
from the Government & out of said debts I
want all of my just debts settled I desire
that after the death of me & my wife Sarah
Goodin that this will shall every Item have
its desired effect and I do hereby revoke all
wills made by me hereafter given under my
hand this the 21st day of July Ad 1873
