At the August Term of the Josh Bell County Court the following Will was produced in the County Court of said County & ordered to be recorded, (C. M. D.)

In the Name of God Amen. I Jack Arther of the County of Knox & State of Kentucky taking into Consideration the frailty of Man and the certainty of death, being by the best information age in the present date 1866. Near sixty years of age yet of a sound mind & good memory. do make my last Will and Testament in the manner and form following to wit. Item the first. I do will and bequeath to Delphy Gibson and her three sons and two daughters. Namely Barton & Bedford and Jefferson. Orleans and Paralel. My land but there is an installment behind unpaid and I want the boys to pay equal parts and if not he that does pay have the more land. I then the second I want Paralel to have one pot one Oven and one Table. This Will is made by me. and given under my hand this February 13th 1866

This the tenth day of May 1870 I Elias Arnet doth make this my last will & Testament & men. I Elias Arnet doth will my soul to god who gave it. I Elias Arnet doth give & bequeath to daughter Serena Arnet all of my lands lying on the North & South sides of Cumberland river Josh County Ky. also I Elias Arnet doth give & bequeath to my daughter Serena Arnet my bay mare & all of my cattle 7 in all. & all of my hogs 14 in all & all of my sheep 17 in all. I Elias Arnet doth give & bequeath to my daughter Serena Arnet all of my household & kitchen furniture together with the appurtenances thereof. I Elias Arnet doth give & bequeath to my daughter Serena Arnet all of my money, notes & accounts after my just debts & funeral expenses are paid. I Elias Arnet doth give & bequeath to my son Barnet S. Arnet one acre of land on which he now lives, on the South side of the river in Josh County Ky. also he give him one horse one cow & calf together with the household & kitchen furniture & many other things too numerous to mention. all to be my own until death & then to be my daughter Serena Arnet to do as she pleases with.
