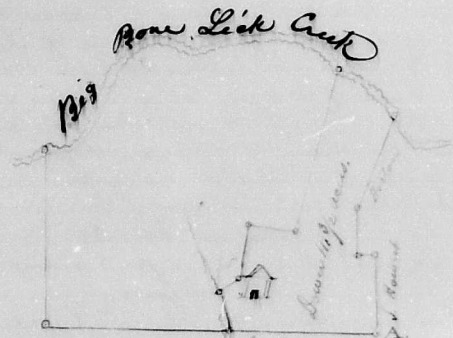

In conformity to an order of Boone County Court April Term 1838 appointing us commissioners to allot and set apart the dower of John M. Parsons in the lands of her deceased husband the late James M. Parsons doo? we the undersigned Commissioners being just duly sworn do report that the real estate of said deceased under our notice consisted of a tract of land lying Boone Lick creek including the late residence of said deceased we ascertained to contain by actual survey 435 acres and 100 which we assigned to the said John M. Parsons widow 111 acres and 3 Rods including the dwelling house and other out buildings as her dower in and to the said tract of 435 acres - We also further report the boundary of the same as follows to wit Beginning at a stake near a sugar tree corner of John Howlet in a line of William Howlet thence with a line of the latter N 1/2 E 134 poles to a stake thence up the spring branch N 88 E 89 poles to the fork of a branch thence up said branch including it S 82 E 11 poles to a stake thence with the corner of the land S 69 E 57 poles to a stake thence S 71 W 28 poles to a stake in the field thence S 65 W 81 poles to two small beech on the west side of Big Bone Lick creek thence down the center thereof by its meanders to a hickory corner of Norton thence with his line N 15 W 88 poles to a stone thence N 80 W 40 poles to a stone thence S 10 W 16 poles to a stone in John Howlet's line thence with it N 18 W 72 poles to the beginning - All of which we respectfully reported under our hands the 4th day of April 1838.
