 being weak in body but of good memory & of sound mind
 but being old and knowing I cannot live long in this mortal
 and having a desire to dispose of my property to my loving
 children in that way that appears most agreeable to me
 make with them — I make this my last will & testament
 Revoking all others made by me heretofore and constitute
 this my last will and testament — firstly I give & bequeath
 the negro boy named Robin to my daughter Alley House to
 her and the heirs of her body to her and her heirs forever —
 Secondly I give and bequeath to the said Selects son of
 Thomas Select one feather Bed to his own use forever —
 Thirdly I give & bequeath to my sons Simeon, Elias and
 Reuben Herman one hundred acres of land lie between them
 three equally — all the remainder part of my
 Estate after my decease to be equally divided between
 them saving that my daughter Alley House shall give
 out of her legacy seventy five dollars in consequence
 of the negro boy, which seventy five dollars is to be
 divided between my sons Simeon, Elias & Reuben Her-
 man — It is my will and desire that my four
 children as above named Alley House, Simeon, Herman
 Elias & Reuben Herman should have all
 my Estate in manner and form as described in the
 body of my will — I now conclude by nominating
 Roger Wigginton, Simeon Herman & Elias Herman my Executors
 to this my last will and testament to pay all my just
 debts and other lawful expenses before any division
 shall take place. Given under my hand and seal the
 21st day of March 1820.
